Peanut Stocks Up 2 Percent From Last Year

Peanut stocks in commercial storage totaled 2.28 billion pounds of equivalent farmer stock, compared to 2.23 billion pounds last year. This total includes 894 million pounds of actual farmer stock.

Shelled peanuts on hand totaled 1.29 billion pounds of equivalent farmer stock. Roasting stock totaled 100 million pounds. There were no Commodity Credit Corporation uncommitted stocks on hand as of April 30, 1993.

Shelled peanut stocks totaled 968 million pounds of which 921 million pounds were edible grades and 47.3 million pounds were oil stocks. Edible grade stocks by type were: Virginias, 170 million pounds; Runners, 665 million pounds; and Spanish, 85.6 million pounds.

April millings totaled 407 million pounds. Millings by type were 70.7 million pounds of Virginias, 298 million pounds of Runners, and 38.1 million pounds of Spanish.

Commercial processors utilized 109 million pounds of **shelled edible** grade peanuts during April. Utilization for all peanut butter products was 58.4 million pounds, utilization for peanut candy was 23.2 million pounds, and utilization for snack peanuts was 24.7 million pounds. **Crushing** for oil, cake, and meal totaled 65.9 million pounds during the month.

Deliveries under the Government Domestic Feeding and Child Nutrition Programs amounted to 6,770,172 pounds of peanut butter and 545,112 pounds of roasted peanuts during the month of April. There were no deliveries of peanut granules.

Stocks of treated seed on hand April 30 totaled 33.6 million pounds, compared with 19.5 million pounds on March 31, 1993. Of the April total, 6.48 million pounds were Virginias and Valencias, 25.5 million pounds were Runners, and 1.58 million pounds were Spanish. March stocks of treated seed included 7.01 million pounds of Virginias and Valencias, 12.5 million pounds of Runners, and 19,000 pounds of Spanish.

These Statistics are collected and presented according to the Peanut Statistics Act which requires shellers, crushers and processors of raw peanuts to submit periodic reports for their operations. These reports are usually based on a complete enumeration of all shellers and crushers and all of the larger processors of raw peanuts. However, reports are occasionally received too late to be included in the first tabulation. Allowances are made for these missing reports and revised totals are published in the next report.

- 1/ Excludes stocks on farms. Includes stocks owned by or held for account of CCC in commercial storages. Farmer stock on net weight basis.
- 2/ Includes shelled edible grades, shelled oil stock, and shelled seed (untreated).
- 3/ Actual farmer stock, plus roasting stock, plus shelled peanuts X 1.33.
- 4/ Includes straight run oil stock peanuts.
- 5/ Cleaned and unshelled.
- 6/ Excludes peanuts milled for seed.
- 7/ Relates to oil mills only.
