Peanut Stocks Up 1 Percent from Last Year

Peanut stocks reported in commercial storage on April 30, 2004 totaled 1.72 billion pounds of equivalent farmer stock, compared to 1.70 billion pounds last year. This total includes 805 million pounds of actual farmer stock.

Shelled peanuts on hand totaled 846 million pounds of farmer stock equivalent. Roasting stock totaled 68.5 million pounds.

Shelled peanut stocks totaled 636 million pounds of which 614 million pounds were edible grades and 22.3 million pounds were oil stocks. Edible grade stocks by type included 91.1 million pounds of Virginias, 486 million pounds of Runners, and 36.3 million pounds of Spanish.

April **millings** totaled 431 million pounds. Millings by type were 81.5 million pounds of Virginias, 333 million pounds of Runners, and 16.3 million pounds of Spanish.

Commercial processors utilized 132 million pounds of **shelled edible** grade peanuts during April. Utilization by type was 69.4 million pounds for all peanut butter products, 29.7 million pounds for peanut candy, and 30.8 million pounds for snack peanuts. **Crushing** for oil and cake and meal totaled 30.1 million pounds during the month.

Deliveries under the Government Domestic Feeding and Child Nutrition Programs amounted to 2.90 million pounds of peanut butter and 66,528 pounds of roasted peanuts during April.

Stocks of treated seed on hand April 30, 2004 totaled 35.6 million pounds, compared with 18.9 million pounds on March 31, 2004. Of the April total, 7.26 million pounds were Virginias and Valencias, 27.3 million pounds were Runners, and 1.02 million pounds were Spanish. March stocks of treated seed included 3.35 million pounds of Virginias and Valencias and 15.6 million pounds of Runners.

Stocks estimates refer to April 30, 2004. All other data are for the month of April.
