

PIG CROP REPORT

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SEPTEMBER 1964

The number of hogs and pigs on farms in the 10 Corn Belt States on September 1, 1964 totaled 47,470,000 head, according to the Crop Reporting Board. This is a decrease of 7 percent from the 50,964,000 head on farms a year earlier and is 5 percent less than the 50,053,000 head on hand September 1, 1962. The 10 States included in this report are Ohio, Indiana, Illinois, Wisconsin, Minnesota, Iowa, Missouri, South Dakota, Nebraska, and Kansas.

Inventory numbers on September 1, 1964 were less than a year earlier in each of the 10 States. Iowa, the leading hog producing State, and South Dakota each were down 3 percent; Ohio and Kansas, each down 6 percent; Illinois, down 8 percent; Indiana and Nebraska, each down 9 percent; Minnesota and Missouri, each down 10 percent; and Wisconsin numbers show the greatest decline at 13 percent. September 1 inventories this year show a seasonal increase of 3 percent from the 46,197,000 head on hand June 1 this year. This may be compared with an increase of 4 percent for the same period a year earlier and a 3 percent increase for the June 1 - September 1, 1962 period.

The number of hogs and pigs on farms September 1, 1964 being kept for breeding in the 10 States totaled 6,124,000 head. This is 6 percent less than the 6,497,000 head of breeding stock on hand a year earlier and reflects the planned reduction in sows farrowing. Hogs and pigs other than those being kept for breeding on farms on September 1, 1964 totaled 41,346,000 head, 7 percent less than the 44,467,000 head on hand September 1, 1963. All weight group classifications of other hogs and pigs show a decline from a year earlier. Classified by weight groups, the number of other hogs and pigs and its percentage change from the previous year are: under 60 pounds, 14,133,000 head, down 11 percent; 60-119 pounds, 11,381,000 head, down 4 percent; 120-179 pounds, 9,888,000 head, down 5 percent; 180-219 pounds, 5,018,000 head, down 4 percent; and 220 pounds and over, 926,000 head, down 7 percent.

JUNE-AUGUST PIG CROP

The June-August 1964 pig crop in the 10 States totaled 16,028,000 head, 8 percent less than the June-August 1963 pig crop of 17,496,000 head. This is the result of a decline of 8 percent in the number of sows farrowed and virtually no change in average number of pigs per litter. The number of sows farrowed at 2,222,000 head compared with 2,419,000 head farrowed during the same quarter of the previous year. All of the States, except Kansas and South Dakota, show a decline in number of sows farrowing. Farrowings in Kansas were 4 percent more than a year earlier and South Dakota farrowings were the same as during the same quarter last year. Declines in farrowings in the 8 remaining States ranged from 4 percent in Iowa to 15 percent in Missouri. On June 1, 1964 farmers in the 10 States reported intentions to decrease farrowings 6 percent during the past quarter. During June 1964 the number of sows farrowed at 760,000 head was 2 percent less than the number farrowed during June of last year. July farrowings at 647,000 head were 9 percent less than during July 1963, and August farrowings at 815,000 head were 12 percent below August a year ago.

SEPTEMBER-NOVEMBER INTENTIONS

Sows bred and intended for farrowing during the September, October, November quarter totaled 2,082,000 head, 5 percent less than a year earlier. All States, except Kansas and Missouri, indicated fewer farrowings than a year earlier. Kansas shows a 3 percent increase in expected farrowings, and Missouri shows the same as a year earlier. Decreases in the other 8 States ranged from 1 percent in each Iowa and South Dakota to 16 percent in Wisconsin. Expected farrowings by months are: September, 1,123,000 sows, 4 percent less than the number farrowed during September of 1963; October, 625,000 sows, down 9 percent from October last year; and 334,000 sows intended for November, about the same as November 1963. The September 1 intention for the September-November quarter is slightly more than the intentions reported for this period on June 1, 1964.

DECEMBER 1964-FEBRUARY 1965 INTENTIONS

Breeding intentions indicate 1,474,000 sows to farrow during the December 1964-February 1965 quarter, 13 percent below the same quarter a year ago. All States indicated declines except South Dakota which shows a 2 percent increase. Declines indicated are: 5 percent in Nebraska; 10 percent in Iowa; 12 percent in each Indiana and Wisconsin; 13 percent in Missouri; 15 percent in each Ohio and Kansas; 17 percent in Illinois; and a decline of 20 percent is expected in Minnesota sow farrowings for this period.
