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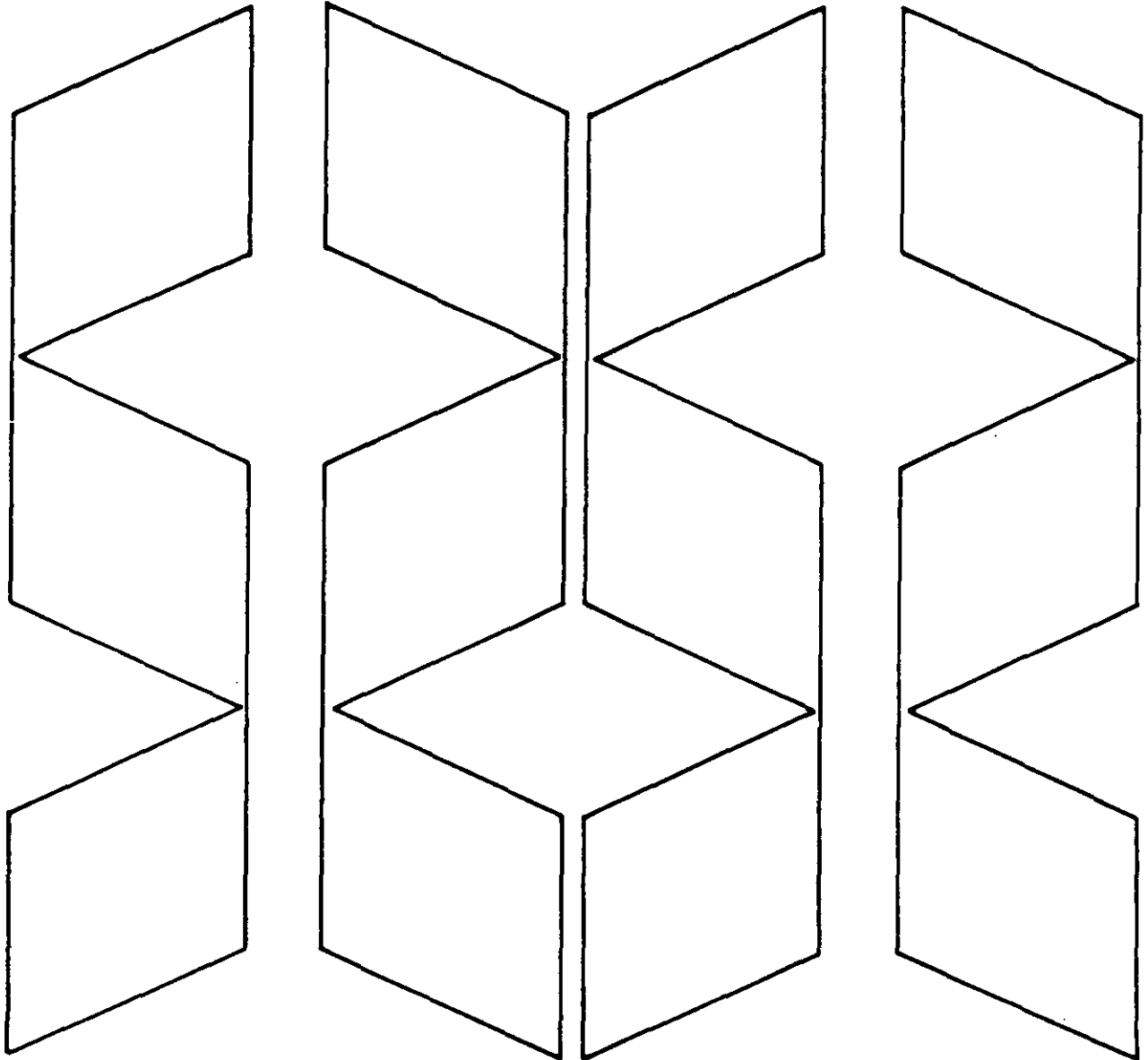

POULTRY

PRODUCTION AND VALUE, BY STATES, 1984-85

This annual publication replaces the previous report titled "Poultry-Production, Disposition, and Income." Estimates for chickens raised, home consumption of eggs and chickens, and related items have been discontinued.

VALUE OF EGG PRODUCTION DOWN 21 PERCENT

Value of egg production in 1985 was \$3.25 billion, down 21 percent from 1984. In 1985, eggs averaged 57.1 cents per dozen, compared with 72.3 cents in 1984.

VALUE OF SALES OF CHICKENS FOR 1985

The value of sales from chickens (excluding broilers) was \$152 million. Prices averaged 14.8 cents per pound live weight.

VALUE OF BROILER PRODUCTION DOWN 6 PERCENT

The value of broilers produced during 1985 was \$5.68 billion, a decrease of 6 percent from the 1984 record high of \$6.02 billion. Record high levels of both birds and weight were more than offset by a lower average price per pound. The total number of broilers produced in 1985 was 4.48 billion, up 5 percent from 1984. A record high total of 18.9 billion pounds (8.55 million metric tons) were produced compared with 17.9 billion pounds (8.10 million metric tons) a year earlier. Prices in 1985 averaged 30.1 cents per pound on a live weight equivalent basis, compared with 33.7 cents during 1984.

VALUE OF TURKEY PRODUCTION UP 10 PERCENT

The value of turkeys produced during 1985 was a record high \$1.82 billion, 10 percent above the \$1.66 billion level of the previous year. An 8 percent increase in the number of head produced and a 1 percent gain in the average weight per bird contributed the most to the new record level. Turkey production in 1985 totaled 3.70 billion pounds (1.68 million metric tons) live weight, compared with 3.39 billion pounds (1.54 million metric tons) in 1984. The price received by producers during 1985 averaged 49.1 cents per pound of live weight, compared with 48.9 cents a year earlier.
