POULTRY USED IN CANNING AND OTHER PROCESSED FOODS
 November 1955.

Poultry used in canning and other processed foods in November totaled 18,694,000 pounds, ready-to-cook weights, compared with 17,064,000 pounds in November last year. The quantity used this year consisted of 15,671,000 pounds of chickens and other poultry and 3,023,000 pounds of turkeys. No comparisons with last year are available for the various classes used.

The quantity of poultry certified under Federal inspection during November totaled 166,669,000 pounds compared with 141,049,000 pounds in November last year. Of this total 65,353,000 pounds were chickens and other poultry and 101,316,000 pounds were turkeys. During November last year, the quantity of poultry certified consisted of 49,006,000 pounds of chickens and 92,043,000 pounds of turkeys.
