Canned and processed poultry - Poultry used in canning and other processed foods during July 1960 totaled 28,554,000 pounds ready-to-cook weight, up 36 percent from the 20,996,000 pounds used in July 1959. The poultry used consisted of 22,045,000 pounds of chickens, 6,491,000 pounds of turkeys and 18,000 pounds of other poultry.

Inspected poultry - The number of head (chickens, turkeys and ducks combined) inspected under the Poultry Products Inspection Act carried on by the U.S. D. A. during July 1960 was 151,512,000, compared with 148,367,000 in July 1959. The number of head and pounds (live weight) inspected by classes were: young chickens, 138,054,000 head, 446,921,000 pounds; mature chickens, 7,757,000 head, 38,284,000 pounds; young turkeys 3,276,000 head, 50,814,000 pounds; old turkeys 338,000 head, 5,984,000 pounds; fryer-roaster turkeys, 905,000 head, 7,980,000 pounds; and ducks, 1,182,000 head, 7,256,000 pounds.

Certified poultry - During July 1960, the quantity of poultry certified as wholesome was 407,330,000 pounds ready-to-cook weight. Of this amount, 323,564,000 pounds were young chickens, 26,559,000 pounds mature chickens, 40,939,000 pounds young turkeys, 4,772,000 pounds old turkeys, 6,179,000 pounds fryer-roaster turkeys, 5,229,000 pounds ducks, and 88,000 pounds other poultry.

Ante-mortem condemnations totaled 1,494,000 pounds (live weight) for all classes. Condemnations, by classes, were equivalent to the following percentages of the live pounds inspected: young chickens 0.28 percent, mature chickens 0.36 percent, young turkeys 0.14 percent, old turkeys 0.19 percent, fryer-roaster turkeys 0.15 percent, and ducks 0.07 percent.

Post-mortem condemnations amounted to 8,968,000 pounds (NYD weight). Condemnations, by classes, were equivalent to the following percentages of the quantities inspected: young chickens 1.84 percent, mature chickens 2.66 percent, young turkeys 0.95 percent, old turkeys 1.34 percent, fryer-roaster turkeys 1.15 percent, and ducks 1.57 percent.

Definitions -

Young chickens - Commercially grown broilers-fryers and other young immature birds such as roasters and capons.

Mature chickens - Fowl from breeder and market egg flocks and stags and cocks.

Fryer-roaster turkeys - Young immature birds, usually under 16 weeks of age.

Young turkeys (mature) - Young birds grown to a matured market age, usually 5 to 7 months.

Old turkeys (breeders) - Fully matured birds held for egg production, usually over 15 months of age.

Ducks - Includes all ducks regardless of age and weight.

Other poultry - Includes all other ready-to-cook products which bear the U.S.D.A. Inspected for Wholesomeness legend.

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
