Slaughtered Under Federal Inspection and
Poultry Used in Canning and Other Processed
Foods - February 1961

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Canned and processed poultry - Poultry used in canning and other processed foods in February 1961 totaled 42,233,000 pounds ready-to-cook weight, compared with 25,563,000 pounds in February 1960. The quantity used consisted of 31,236,000 pounds of chicken, 8,362,000 pounds of turkey and 2,635,000 pounds of other poultry.

Inspected poultry - The number of head (chickens, turkeys, and ducks combined) inspected under the Poultry Products Inspection Act carried on by the U.S.D.A. totaled 113,134,000 during February 1961, compared with 114,857,000 in February 1960. The number of head and pounds (live weight) inspected by classes were: young chickens, 105,353,000 head, 354,813,000 pounds; mature chickens, 6,093,000 head, 29,190,000 pounds; young turkeys, 569,000 head, 10,888,000 pounds; old turkeys, 106,000 head, 2,034,000 pounds; fryer-roaster turkeys, 829,000 head, 7,345,000 pounds; and ducks, 184,000 head, 1,120,000 pounds.

Certified poultry - During February 1961, the quantity of poultry certified as wholesome was 293,298,000 pounds ready-to-cook weight. Of this amount, 255,786,000 pounds were young chickens, 20,550,000 pounds mature chickens, 8,716,000 pounds young turkeys, 1,631,000 pounds old turkeys, 5,782,000 pounds fryer-roaster turkeys, 785,000 pounds ducks, and 48,000 pounds other poultry.

Ante-mortem condemnations totaled 995,000 pounds (live weight) for all classes. Condemnations, by classes, were equivalent to the following percentages of the live pounds inspected: young chickens 0.25 percent, mature chickens 0.31 percent, young turkeys 0.10 percent, old turkeys 0.15 percent, fryer-roaster turkeys 0.20 percent, and ducks 0.07 percent.

Post-mortem condemnations amounted to 7,816,000 pounds (NYD weight). Condemnations, by classes, were equivalent to the following percentages of the quantities inspected: young chickens 2.17 percent, mature chickens 2.52 percent, young turkeys 1.14 percent, old turkeys 1.86 percent, fryer-roaster turkeys 1.27 percent, and ducks 2.48 percent.

Definitions -

Young chickens - Commercially grown broilers-fryers and other young immature birds such as roasters and capons.

Mature chickens - Fowl from breeder and market egg flocks and stags and cocks.

Fryer-roaster turkeys - Young immature birds, usually under 16 weeks of age.

Young turkeys (mature) - Young birds grown to a matured market age, usually 5 to 7 months.

Old turkeys (breeders) - Fully matured birds held for egg production, usually over 15 months of age.

Ducks - Includes all ducks regardless of age and weight.

Other poultry - Includes all other ready-to-cook products which bear the U.S.D.A. Inspected for Wholesomeness legend.

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The data presented in this report were compiled from reports collected by the Inspection Branch of the Poultry Division, Agricultural Marketing Service.
