Inspected Poultry - There were 1,287 million pounds live weight (chickens, turkeys, and ducks) inspected for slaughter during August 1971 under the Poultry Inspection Act carried on by United States Department of Agriculture. This is 11 percent more than the previous month and 7 percent more than August 1970.

The number of head and pounds live weight inspected by classes were: young chickens - 257,296,000 head, 940,052,000 pounds; mature chickens - 12,704,000 head, 58,337,000 pounds; fryer-roaster turkeys - 966,000 head, 8,582,000 pounds; young turkeys - 14,061,000 head, 270,133,000 pounds; old turkeys - 97,000 head, 1,798,000 pounds; and ducks - 1,322,000 head, 8,032,000 pounds.

Poultry Certified Wholesome in August totaled 938,167,000 pounds ready-to-cook weight of which 674,214,000 pounds were chilled and 263,953,000 pounds were frozen. Pounds certified by class of poultry were: young chickens, 673,730,000; mature chickens, 37,268,000; fryer-roaster turkeys, 6,568,000; young turkeys, 213,233,000; old turkeys, 1,411,000; ducks, 5,720,000; and other poultry, 237,000 pounds.

Further-Processed - Poultry inspected and used for further processing totaled 130,813,000 pounds ready-to-cook weight, compared with 112,207,000 pounds in August 1970. The August 1971 total consisted of 31,851,000 pounds young chickens, 34,054,000 pounds mature chickens, 58,551,000 pounds of turkeys and 6,357,000 pounds of other poultry.

Poultry Cut-up and Packaged totaled 207,964,000 pounds ready-to-cook weight, compared with 179,122,000 pounds in August 1970. The breakdown by class was: young chickens, 188,019,000 pounds; mature chickens, 562,000; turkeys, 19,083,000; and other poultry, 300,000 pounds.

Ante-Mortem Condemnations during August were 6,072,000 pounds live weight. Condemnations by class as a percent of quantities inspected were: young chickens, 0.52; mature chickens, 0.87; fryer-roaster turkeys 0.18; young turkeys, 0.23; old turkeys, 0.24 and ducks 0.04.

Post-Mortem Condemnations in August were 34,615,000 pounds (NYD weight). Condemnations by class as a percent of quantities inspected were: young chickens, 3.00; mature chickens, 5.49; fryer-roaster turkeys, 1.98; young turkeys, 2.51; old turkeys, 3.66; and ducks, 1.62.

Definitions

Young chickens - Commercially grown broilers-fryers and other young immature birds such as roasters and capons.

Mature chickens - Fowl from breeder and market egg flocks and stags and cocks.

Fryer-roaster turkeys - Young immature birds, usually under 16 weeks of age.

Young turkeys (mature) - Young birds grown to a matured market age, usually 5 to 7 months.

Old turkeys (breeders) - Fully matured birds held for egg production, usually over 15 months of age.

Ducks - Includes all ducks regardless of age and weight.

Other poultry - Includes all other ready-to-cook products which bear the U.S.D.A. Inspected for Wholesomeness legend.
