Inspected Poultry - There were 1,235 million pounds live-weight of poultry (chickens, turkeys and ducks) inspected for slaughter during June 1974 by the United States Department of Agriculture. This is 3 percent less than the previous month but 2 percent above June 1973.

Young chickens inspected totaled 953 million pounds, down 8 percent from last month but 1 percent more than June 1973. Mature chickens inspected totaled 71.8 million pounds, 15 percent below last month and 6 percent less than last year. Total turkeys inspected at 202 million pounds, were up 40 percent from the previous month and 12 percent from June 1973. Duck inspections, at 8.0 million pounds, were up 3 percent from last month and 3 percent from June 1973.

Poultry Certified Wholesome in June totaled 899 million pounds ready-to-cook weight -- down 2 percent from May 1974 but up 2 percent from June 1973. Of the June 1974 total, 78 percent was chilled and 22 percent was frozen.

Further Processed poultry totaled 144 million pounds ready-to-cook weight-- down 2 percent from May 1974 but up 2 percent from June 1973.

Poultry Cut-up and Packaged totaled 229 million pounds ready-to-cook weight-- down 6 percent from last month and 2 percent from June 1973.

Ante-Mortem Condemnations during June were 5.3 million pounds live-weight. This was 0.42 percent of total quantities inspected, compared with 0.56 percent a year ago. Post-Mortem Condemnations were 27.0 million pounds (NYD weight). This was 2.44 percent of quantities inspected, compared with 2.70 percent in June 1973.

Total Poultry Slaughtered (including that slaughtered in non-federally inspected plants) during June 1974 was 920 million pounds, down 3 percent from last month but 1 percent more than June 1973.

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Definitions

Young chickens.-- Commercially grown broilers-fryers and other young immature birds such as roasters and capons.

Mature chickens - Fowl from breeder and market egg flocks and stags and cocks.

Fryer-roaster turkeys - Young immature birds, usually under 16 weeks of age.

Young turkeys (mature) - Young birds grown to a matured market age, usually 5 to 7 months.

Old turkeys (breeders) - Fully matured birds held for egg production, usually over 15 months of age.

Ducks - Includes all ducks regardless of age and weight.

Other poultry - Includes all other ready-to-cook products which bear the U.S.D.A. Inspected for Wholesomeness legend.
