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Inspected Poultry - There were 1,069 million pounds live weight of poultry inspected for slaughter during November 1974 by the United States Department of Agriculture. This is 18 percent less than November 1973 and 21 percent less than the previous month.

November 1974 included 20 weekdays, excluding Thanksgiving, and 5 Saturdays compared with 21 weekdays, excluding Thanksgiving, and 4 Saturdays for November 1973.

Young chickens inspected totaled 727 million pounds, 19 percent below November 1973. These inspections were 24 percent less than last month. Mature chickens inspected totaled 63.3 million pounds, 3 percent less than last year and down 4 percent from last month. Total turkeys inspected at 272 million pounds were down 20 percent from a year ago and 18 percent from October 1974. Duck inspections at 4.9 million pounds were down 12 percent from November 1973 and 31 percent from the previous month.

Poultry Certified Wholesome in November totaled 785 million pounds ready-to-cook weight -- down 18 percent from November 1973 and 21 percent from the previous month. Of the November 1974 total, 73 percent was chilled and 27 percent was frozen.

Further Processed poultry totaled 171 million pounds ready-to-cook weight -- down 12 percent from November 1973 and 19 percent from October 1974.

Poultry Cut-up and Packaged totaled 210 million pounds ready-to-cook weight -- down 6 percent from November 1973 and 18 percent from last month.

Ante-Mortem Condemnations during November were 3.4 million pounds live weight. This was 0.31 percent of total quantities inspected, compared with 0.38 percent a year ago. Post-Mortem Condemnations were 21.3 million pounds (NYD weight). This was 2.22 percent of total quantities inspected, compared with 2.63 percent in November 1973.

Total Poultry Slaughtered (including that slaughtered in non-federally inspected plants) during November 1974 was 800 million pounds ready-to-cook weight, down 19 percent from November 1973 and 21 percent from last month.

Definitions

Young chickens - Commercially grown broilers-fryers and other young immature birds such as roasters and capons.

Mature chickens - Fowl from breeder and market egg flocks and stags and cocks.

Fryer-roaster turkeys - Young immature birds, usually under 16 weeks of age.

Young turkeys (mature) - Young birds grown to a matured market age, usually 5 to 7 months.

Old turkeys (breeders) - Fully matured birds held for egg production, usually over 15 months of age.

Ducks - Includes all ducks regardless of age and weight.

Other poultry - Includes all other ready-to-cook products which bear the U.S.D.A. Inspected for Wholesomeness legend.
