Inspected Poultry - There were 1,055 million pounds live weight of poultry inspected for slaughter during January 1975 by the United States Department of Agriculture. This is 2 percent above the previous month but 12 percent less than January 1974.

Young chickens inspected totaled 892 million pounds, 9 percent more than the previous month, but 10 percent below January 1974. Mature chickens inspected totaled 76 million pounds, 26 percent above the previous month but 4 percent less than last year. Total turkeys inspected at 83 million pounds were down 46 percent from a month earlier and 34 percent from January 1974. Duck inspections at 3.7 million pounds were 20 percent below the previous month and 14 percent below January 1974.

Poultry Certified Wholesome in January totaled 762 million pounds ready-to-cook weight -- up 1 percent from the previous month but down 12 percent from January 1974. Of the January 1975 total, 85 percent was chilled and 15 percent was frozen.

Further Processed poultry totaled 124 million pounds ready-to-cook weight -- down 8 percent from the previous month and 20 percent from January 1974.

Poultry Cut-up and Packaged totaled 235 million pounds ready-to-cook weight -- up 7 percent from December 1974 but 4 percent below last year.

Ante-Mortem Condemnations during January were 4.3 million pounds live weight. This was 0.40 percent of total quantities inspected, compared with 0.48 percent a year ago. Post-Mortem Condemnations were 21.0 million pounds (NYD weight). This was 2.22 percent of total quantities inspected, compared with 2.91 percent in January 1974.

Total Poultry Slaughtered (including that slaughtered in non-federally inspected plants) during January 1975 was 781 million pounds ready-to-cook weight, up 2 percent from December 1974, but down 16 percent from January 1974.

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DEFINITIONS

YOUNG CHICKENS - COMMERCIALY GROWN BROILERS-FRYERS AND OTHER YOUNG IMMATURE BIRDS SUCH AS ROASTERS AND CAPONS.

MATURE CHICKENS - FOWL FROM BREEDER AND MARKET EGG FLOCKS AND STAGS AND COCKS.

FRYER-ROASTER TURKEYS - YOUNG IMMATURE BIRDS, USUALLY UNDER 16 WEEKS OF AGE.

YOUNG TURKEYS (MATURE) - YOUNG BIRDS GROWN TO A MATURED MARKET AGE, USUALLY 5 TO 7 MONTHS.

OLD TURKEYS (BREEDERS) - FULLY MATURED BIRDS HELD FOR EGG PRODUCTION, USUALLY OVER 15 MONTHS OF AGE.

DUCKS - INCLUDES ALL DUCKS REGARDLESS OF AGE AND WEIGHT.

OTHER POULTRY - INCLUDES ALL OTHER READY-TO-COOK PRODUCTS WHICH BEAR THE U.S.D.A. INSPECTED FOR WHOLESOMENESS LEGEND.

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THE DATA PRESENTED IN THIS REPORT WERE COMPILED FROM REPORTS COLLECTED BY THE MEAT AND POULTRY INSPECTION PROGRAM, ANIMAL AND PLANT HEALTH INSPECTION SERVICE.
