Inspected Poultry - There were 1,184 million pounds live weight of poultry inspected for slaughter by the United States Department of Agriculture during June 1975. This is 4 percent less than June 1974, but 6 percent above May 1975.

Young chickens inspected totaled 939 million pounds, 1 percent below both June 1974 and last month. Mature chickens inspected totaled 61.2 million pounds, 15 percent less than last year but 5 percent more than May 1975. Total turkeys inspected at 175 million pounds were down 13 percent from a year ago but up 70 percent from last month. Duck inspections at 8.2 million pounds were up 3 percent from June 1974 and 16 percent from the previous month.

Poultry Certified Wholesome in June totaled 866 million pounds ready-to-cook weight -- down 4 percent from June 1974 but up 6 percent from last month. Of the June 1975 total, 81 percent was chilled and 19 percent was frozen.

Further Processed poultry totaled 151 million pounds ready-to-cook weight -- up 5 percent from June 1974 and 33 percent above last month.

Poultry Cut-up and Packaged totaled 255 million pounds ready-to-cook weight -- up 12 percent from June 1974 and 7 percent more than the previous month.

Ante-Mortem Condemnations during June were 4.2 million pounds live weight. This was 0.35 percent of total quantities inspected, compared with 0.42 percent a year ago. Post-Mortem Condemnations were 19.1 million pounds (NYD weight). This is 1.79 percent of total quantities inspected, compared with 2.44 percent in June 1974.

Total Poultry Slaughtered (including that slaughtered in non-federally inspected plants) during June 1975 was 884 million pounds ready-to-cook weight, down 4 percent from June 1974 but up 6 percent from last month.

MATURE CHICKENS - FOWL FROM BREEDER AND MARKET EGG FLOCKS AND STAGS AND COCKS.

FRYER-ROASTER TURKEYS - YOUNG IMMATURE BIRDS, USUALLY UNDER 16 WEEKS OF AGE.

YOUNG TURKEYS (MATURE) - YOUNG BIRDS GROWN TO A MATURED MARKET AGE, USUALLY 5 TO 7 MONTHS.

OLD TURKEYS (BREEDERS) - FULLY MATURED BIRDS HELD FOR EGG PRODUCTION, USUALLY OVER 15 MONTHS OF AGE.

DUCKS - INCLUDES ALL DUCKS REGARDLESS OF AGE AND WEIGHT.

OTHER POULTRY - INCLUDES ALL OTHER READY-TO-COOK PRODUCTS WHICH BEAR THE U.S.D.A INSPECTED FOR WHOLESOMENESS LEGEND.
