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Inspected Poultry - There were 1,300 million pounds live weight of poultry inspected for slaughter by the United States Department of Agriculture during September 1975. This is 8 percent more than September 1974 and 4 percent above August 1975.

Young chickens inspected totaled 943 million pounds, 10 percent above September 1974 and 1 percent more than last month. Mature chickens inspected totaled 61.0 million pounds, 10 percent more than last year and 13 percent above August 1975. Total turkeys inspected at 288 million pounds were up 4 percent from a year ago and 12 percent from last month. Duck inspections at 7.0 million pounds were down 1 percent from September 1974 but up 5 percent from the previous month.

Poultry Certified Wholesome in September totaled 958 million pounds ready-to-cook weight -- up 9 percent from September 1974 and 4 percent more than last month. Of the September 1975 total, 74 percent was chilled and 26 percent was frozen.

Further Processed poultry totaled 202 million pounds ready-to-cook weight -- up 12 percent from September 1974 and 6 percent more than the previous month.

Poultry Cut-up and Packaged totaled 250 million pounds ready-to-cook weight -- up 10 percent from September 1974 but 5 percent below last month.

Ante-Mortem Condemnations during September were 4.1 million pounds live-weight. This was 0.31 percent of total quantities inspected, compared with 0.34 percent a year ago. Post-Mortem Condemnations were 23.2 million pounds (NYD weight). This is 1.98 percent of total quantities inspected, compared with 2.37 percent in September 1974.

Total Poultry Slaughtered (including that slaughtered in non-federally inspected plants) during September 1975 was 978 million pounds ready-to-cook weight, up 9 percent from September 1974 and 4 percent more than last month.

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DEFINITIONS

Young chickens - Commercially grown broilers-fryers and other young immature birds such as roasters and capons.

Mature chickens - Fowl from breeder and market egg flocks and stags and cocks.

Fryer-roaster turkeys - Young immature birds, usually under 16 weeks of age.

Young turkeys (mature) - Young birds grown to a matured market age, usually 5 to 7 months.

Old turkeys (breeders) - Fully matured birds held for egg production, usually over 15 months of age.

Ducks - Includes all ducks regardless of age and weight.

Other poultry - Includes all other ready-to-cook products which bear the U.S.D.A. Inspected for Wholesomeness legend.
