Inspected Poultry - There were 1,423 million pounds live weight of poultry inspected for slaughter by the United States Department of Agriculture during October 1975. This is 5 percent more than October 1974 and 9 percent above September 1975.

Young chickens inspected totaled 1,022 million pounds, 8 percent above both October 1974 and September 1975. Mature chickens inspected totaled 67.5 million pounds, 2 percent more than last year and 11 percent above September 1975. Total turkeys inspected at 324 million pounds were down 2 percent from a year ago but up 12 percent from last month. Duck inspections at 6.7 million pounds were down 6 percent from October 1974 and 4 percent from last month.

Poultry Certified Wholesome in October totaled 1,046 million pounds ready-to-cook weight --- up 5 percent from October 1974 and 9 percent more than last month. Of the October 1975 total, 73 percent was chilled and 27 percent was frozen.

Further Processed poultry totaled 232 million pounds ready-to-cook weight --- up 11 percent from October 1974 and 15 percent more than the previous month.

Poultry Cut-up and Packaged totaled 267 million pounds ready-to-cook weight --- up 4 percent from October 1974 and 7 percent above last month.

Ante-Mortem Condemnations during October were 3.8 million pounds live weight. This was 0.26 percent of total quantities inspected, compared with 0.30 percent a year ago. Post Mortem Condemnations were 24.5 million pounds (NYD weight). This is 1.91 percent of total quantities inspected, compared with 2.25 percent in October 1974.

Total Poultry Slaughtered (including that slaughtered in non-federally inspected plants) during October 1975 was 1,067 million pounds ready-to-cook weight, up 5 percent from October 1974 and 9 percent more than last month.

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Definitions

Young chickens - Commercially grown broilers-fryers and other young immature birds such as roasters and capons.

Mature chickens - fowl from breeder and market egg flocks and stags and cocks.

Fryer-roaster turkeys - Young immature birds, usually under 16 weeks of age.

Young turkeys (mature) - Young birds grown to a matured market age, usually 5 to 7 months.

Old turkeys (breeders) - Fully matured birds held for egg production, usually over 15 months of age.

Ducks - Includes all ducks regardless of age and weight.

Other poultry - Includes all other ready-to-cook products which bear the U.S.D.A. Inspected for Wholesomeness legend.
