Inspected Poultry - There were 1,110 million pounds live weight of poultry inspected for slaughter by the United States Department of Agriculture during November 1975. This is 4 percent more than November 1974 but 22 percent below October 1975.

Young chickens inspected totaled 775 million pounds, 7 percent above November 1974 but 24 percent below last month. Mature chickens inspected totaled 50.1 million pounds, 21 percent less than last year and 26 percent below October 1975. Total turkeys inspected at 277 million pounds were up 2 percent from a year ago but down 14 percent from last month. Duck inspections at 5.3 million pounds were up 7 percent from November 1974 but down 21 percent from last month.

Poultry Certified Wholesome in November totaled 818 million pounds ready-to-cook weight -- up 4 percent from November 1974 but 22 percent less than last month. Of the November 1975 total, 74 percent was chilled and 26 percent was frozen.

Further Processed poultry totaled 187 million pounds ready-to-cook weight -- up 9 percent from November 1974 but down 20 percent from October 1975.

Poultry Cut-up and Packaged totaled 220 million pounds ready-to-cook weight -- up 4 percent from November 1974 but 18 percent below last month.

Ante-Mortem Condemnations during November were 3.0 million pounds live weight. This was 0.27 percent of total quantities inspected, compared with 0.31 percent a year ago. Post-Mortem Condemnations were 18.7 million pounds (NYD weight). This is 1.87 percent of total quantities inspected, compared with 2.22 percent in November 1974.

Total Poultry Slaughtered (including that slaughtered in non-federally inspected plants) during November 1975 was 834 million pounds ready-to-cook weight, up 4 percent from November 1974 but 22 percent less than last month.

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Definitions

Young chickens - Commercially grown broilers-fryers and other young immature birds such as roasters and capons.

Mature chickens - Fowl from breeder and market egg flocks and stags and cocks.

Fryer-roaster turkeys - Young immature birds, usually under 16 weeks of age.

Young turkeys (mature) - Young birds grown to a matured market age, usually 5 to 7 months.

Old turkeys (breeders) - Fully matured birds held for egg production, usually over 15 months of age.

Ducks - Includes all ducks regardless of age and weight.

Other poultry - Includes all other ready-to-cook products which bear the U.S.D.A. Inspected for Wholesomeness legend.
