INSPECTED POULTRY - There were 1,442 million pounds live weight of poultry inspected for slaughter during June 1976 by the United States Department of Agriculture. This is 22 percent more than in June 1975 and 18 percent above May 1976.

Young chickens inspected totaled 1,138 million pounds, up 21 percent from June 1975 and 11 percent above May 1976. Mature chickens inspected totaled 65.3 million pounds, 7 percent more than last year and 19 percent above May 1976. Total turkeys inspected at 230 million pounds were up 31 percent from a year ago and 71 percent above May. Ducks inspected during June 1976 at 9.0 million pounds were up 10 percent from last year and 21 percent above the previous month.

POULTRY CERTIFIED WHOLESOME in June totaled 1,056 million pounds ready-to-cook weight -- up 22 percent from June 1975 and 18 percent above May 1976. Of the June 1976 total, 79 percent was chilled and 21 percent was frozen.

FURTHER PROCESSED poultry totaled 202 million pounds ready-to-cook weight -- up 34 percent from June 1975 and 21 percent more than May 1976.

POULTRY CUT-UP AND PACKAGED totaled 303 million pounds ready-to-cook weight -- up 19 percent from June 1975 and 6 percent above the previous month.

ANTE-MORTEM CONDEMNATION during June 1976 were 5.3 million pounds live-weight. This was 0.36 percent of quantities inspected, compared with 0.35 percent a year ago. Post Mortem Condemnations were 24.3 million pounds (N.Y.D. weight). This was 1.87 percent of quantities inspected, compared with 1.79 percent in June 1975.

TOTAL POULTRY SLAUGHTERED (including that slaughtered in non-federally inspected plants) during June 1976, was 1,077 million pounds ready-to-cook weight, up 22 percent from June 1975 and 18 percent above May 1976.

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Definitions

Young chickens - Commercially grown broilers-fryers and other young immature birds such as roasters and capons.

Mature chickens - Fowl from breeder and market egg flocks and stags and cocks.

Fryer-roaster turkeys - Young immature birds, usually under 16 weeks of age.

Young turkeys (mature) - Young birds grown to a matured market age, usually 5 to 7 months.

Old turkeys (breeders) - Fully matured birds held for egg production, usually over 15 months of age.

Ducks - Includes all ducks regardless of age and weight.

Other poultry - Includes all other ready-to-cook products which bear the U.S.D.A. Inspected for Wholesomeness legend.
