Inspected Poultry - There were 1,399 million pounds live weight of poultry inspected for slaughter during July 1976 by the United States Department of Agriculture. This is 9 percent more than in July 1975 but 3 percent less than June 1976.

Young chickens inspected totaled 1,059 million pounds, up 8 percent from July 1975 but 7 percent below June 1976. Mature chickens inspected totaled 61.6 million pounds, 13 percent more than last year but 6 percent below June 1976. Total turkeys inspected at 270 million pounds were up 11 percent from a year ago and 17 percent above June. Ducks inspected during July 1976 at 8.2 million pounds were up 9 percent from last year but 9 percent below the previous month.

Poultry Certified Wholesome in July totaled 1,025 million pounds ready-to-cook weight -- up 8 percent from July 1975 but 3 percent below June 1976. Of the July 1976 total, 76 percent was chilled and 24 percent was frozen.

Further Processed poultry totaled 203 million pounds ready-to-cook weight -- up 14 percent from July 1975 and 1 percent more than June 1976.

Poultry Cut-up and Packaged totaled 314 million pounds ready-to-cook weight -- up 18 percent from July 1975 and 4 percent more than the previous month.

Ante-Mortem Condemnation during July 1976 were 6.0 million pounds live weight. This was 0.43 percent of quantities inspected, compared with 0.40 percent a year ago. Post-Mortem Condemnation were 24.1 million pounds (N.Y.D. weight). This was 1.92 percent of quantities inspected, compared with 1.80 percent in July 1975.

Total Poultry Slaughtered (including that slaughtered in non-federally inspected plants) during July 1976, was 1,045 million pounds ready-to-cook weight, up 8 percent from July 1975 but 3 percent below June, 1976.

Definitions

Young chickens - Commercially grown broilers-fryers and other young immature birds such as roasters and capons.

Mature chickens - Fowl from breeder and market egg flocks and stags and cocks.

Fryer-roaster turkeys - Young immature birds, usually under 16 weeks of age.

Young turkeys (mature) - Young birds grown to a matured market age, usually 5 to 7 months.

Old turkeys (breeders) - Fully matured birds held for egg production, usually over 15 months of age.

Ducks - Includes all ducks regardless of age and weight.

Other poultry - Includes all other ready-to-cook products which bear the U.S.D.A. Inspected for Wholesomeness legend.
