Inspected Poultry - There were 1,488 million pounds live weight of poultry inspected for slaughter during August 1976 by the United States Department of Agriculture. This is 19 percent more than in August 1975 and 6 percent above July 1976.

Young chickens inspected totaled 1,112 million pounds, up 19 percent from August 1975 and 5 percent more than July 1976. Mature chickens inspected totaled 61.0 million pounds, 13 percent more than last year but 1 percent below July 1976. Total turkeys inspected at 307 million pounds were up 20 percent from a year ago and 14 percent above July. Ducks inspected during August 1976 at 8.5 million pounds were up 28 percent from last year and 3 percent above the previous month.

Poultry Certified Wholesome in August totaled 1,093 million pounds ready-to-cook --- up 18 percent from August 1975 and 7 percent above July 1976. Of the August 1976 total, 75 percent was chilled and 25 percent was frozen.

Further Processed poultry totaled 226 million pounds ready-to-cook weights --- up 19 percent from August 1975 and 11 percent more than July 1976.

Poultry Cut-up and Packaged totaled 324 million pounds ready-to-cook weight --- up 23 percent from August 1975 and 3 percent more than the previous month.

Ante-Mortem Condemnation during August 1976 were 5.4 million pounds live weight. This was 0.36 percent of quantities inspected, compared with 0.42 percent a year ago. Post Mortem Condemnation were 26.2 million pounds (N.Y.D. weight). This was 1.96 percent of quantities inspected, compared with 1.90 percent in August 1975.

Total Poultry Slaughtered (including that slaughtered in non-federally inspected plants) was 1,115 million pounds ready-to-cook weight, up 18 percent from August 1975 and 7 percent above July 1976.

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Definitions

Young chickens - Commercially grown broilers-fryers and other young immature birds such as roasters and capons.

Mature chickens - Fowl from breeder and market egg flocks and stags and cocks.

Fryer-roaster turkeys - Young immature birds, usually under 16 weeks of age.

Young turkeys (mature) - Young birds grown to a matured market age, usually 5 to 7 months.

Old turkeys (breeders) - Fully matured birds held for egg production, usually over 15 months of age.

Ducks - Includes all ducks regardless of age and weight.

Other poultry - Includes all other ready-to-cook products which bear the U.S.D.A. Inspected for Wholesomeness legend.

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The data presented in this report were compiled from reports collected by the Meat and Poultry Inspection Program, Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service.
