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INSPECTED POULTRY - There were 1.4 billion pounds live weight of poultry inspected for slaughter during November 1976 by the United States Department of Agriculture. This is 23 percent more than November 1975 but 7 percent below October 1976.

Young chickens inspected totaled 967 million pounds, up 25 percent from November 1975 but down 9 percent from October 1976. Mature chickens inspected totaled 55.5 million pounds, 11 percent more than last year but 12 percent below October 1976. Total turkeys inspected at 329 million pounds were up 19 percent from a year ago and 2 percent above last month. Ducks inspected during November 1976 at 7.0 million pounds were 32 percent above November last year but 8 percent below the previous month.

POULTRY CERTIFIED WHOLESOME in November totaled 1.0 billion pounds ready-to-cook weight -- up 23 percent from November 1975 but 7 percent below October 1976. Of the November 1976 total, 74 percent was chilled and 26 percent was frozen.

FURTHER PROCESSED poultry totaled 213 million pounds ready-to-cook weight -- up 14 percent from November 1975 but 8 percent less than October 1976.

POULTRY CUT-UP AND PACKAGED totaled 290 million pounds ready-to-cook weight -- up 32 percent from November 1975 but 9 percent less than October this year.

ANTE-MORTEM CONDEMNATION during November 1976 totaled 4.2 million pounds live weight. This is 0.30 percent of quantities inspected, compared with 0.27 percent a year ago. Post-Mortem Condemnations were 25.4 million pounds (NYD weight). This is 2.08 percent of quantities inspected, compared with 1.87 percent in November 1975.

TOTAL POULTRY SLAUGHTERED (including that slaughtered in non-federally inspected plants) was 1.02 billion pounds ready-to-cook weight, up 22 percent from November 1975 but 7 percent below October 1976.

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DEFINITIONS

- YOUNG CHICKENS - Commercially grown broilers-fryers and other young immature birds such as roasters and capons.
- MATURE CHICKENS - Fowl from breeder and market egg flocks and stags and cocks.
- FRYER-ROASTER TURKEYS - Young immature birds, usually under 16 weeks of age.
- YOUNG TURKEYS (MATURE) - Young birds grown to a matured market age, usually 5 to 7 months.
- OLD TURKEYS (BREEDERS) - Fully matured birds held for egg production, usually over 15 months of age.
- DUCKS - Includes all ducks regardless of age and weight.
- OTHER POULTRY - Includes all other ready-to-cook products which bear the USDA Inspected for Wholesomeness legend.

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The data presented in this report were compiled from reports collected by the Meat and Poultry Inspection Program, Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service.
