Inspected Poultry - The U.S. Department of Agriculture inspected 1.5 billion pounds live weight of poultry for slaughter during June 1977, 2 percent more than in June 1976 and 10 percent above May 1977.

Inspections included 1.2 billion pounds of young chickens, up 2 percent from June 1976 and 4 percent above May 1977; 78 million pounds of mature chickens, a 20 percent increase from last year and 9 percent above last month. Turkey inspections totaled 223 million pounds, down 3 percent from a year earlier but 60 percent above May. During June this year 9.3 million pounds of ducks were inspected, 4 percent above last year and 22 percent more than May 1977.

Poultry Certified Wholesome in June totaled 1,075 million pounds ready-to-cook weight --- up 2 percent from June 1976 and 11 percent more than last month. Of the June 1977 total, 81 percent was chilled and 19 percent was frozen.

Further Processed poultry totaled 213 million pounds ready-to-cook weight --- up 5 percent from June 1976 and 20 percent more than May 1977.

Poultry Cut-up and Packaged totaled 356 million pounds ready-to-cook weight, up 17 percent from June 1976 and 6 percent more than May this year.

Anti-Mortem Condemnations during June 1977 were 6.6 million pounds live weight. This was 0.44 percent of total quantities inspected, compared with 0.36 percent a year ago. Post Mortem Condemnations were 25.5 million pounds (NYD weight). This is 1.93 percent of total quantities inspected, compared with 1.87 percent in June 1976.

Total Poultry Slaughtered (including that slaughtered in non-federally inspected plants) during June 1977 was 1,095 million pounds ready-to-cook weight, up 2 percent from June 1976 and 11 percent more than May 1977.

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Definitions

Young chickens - Commercially grown broilers-fryers and other young immature birds such as roasters and capons.

Mature chickens - Fowl from breeder and market egg flocks and stags and cocks.

Fryer-roaster turkeys - Young immature birds, usually under 16 weeks of age.

Young turkeys (mature) - Young birds grown to a matured market age, usually 5 to 7 months.

Old turkeys (breeders) - Fully matured birds held for egg production, usually over 15 months of age.

Ducks - Includes all ducks regardless of age and weight.

Other poultry - Includes all other ready-to-cook products which bear the U.S.D.A. Inspected for Wholesomeness legend.
