

POULTRY SLAUGHTER



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November 1978

LIVEWEIGHT POULTRY INSPECTION totaled 1.46 billion pounds during November 1978, 6 percent above November 1977 but 12 percent less than October 1978, according to the Crop Reporting Board.

Inspection included 1.07 billion pounds of young chickens, up 8 percent from November 1977 but 13 percent below October 1978; 60.9 million pounds of mature chickens, slightly below last year and 16 percent less than last month. Turkey inspections totaled 314 million pounds, up 1 percent from a year earlier but 8 percent less than October 1978. During November this year, 8.77 million pounds of ducks were inspected, up 27 percent from November 1977 but 9 percent less than October 1978.

POULTRY CERTIFIED WHOLESOME in November totaled 1.07 billion pounds ready-to-cook weight, up 6 percent from November 1977 but 12 percent below October 1978. Of the November 1978 total, 77 percent was chilled and 23 percent frozen.

FURTHER PROCESSED poultry totaled 259 million pounds ready-to-cook weight, up 17 percent from November 1977 but 13 percent below October 1978.

CUT-UP PACKAGED totaled 354 million pounds ready-to-cook weight, up 7 percent from November 1977 but 7 percent less than October this year.

ANTE-MORTEM CONDEMNATIONS during November 1978 were 4.94 million pounds liveweight. This was 0.33 percent of quantities inspected, compared with 0.30 percent a year ago. POST-MORTEM CONDEMNATIONS were 27.2 million pounds (N.Y.D. weight). This was 2.07 percent of quantities inspected, compared with 1.99 percent in November 1977.

POULTRY SLAUGHTERED (included that slaughtered in non-federally inspected plants) during November was 1.08 billion pounds ready-to-cook weight, up 5 percent from November 1977 but 12 percent less than October 1978.

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Definitions

Young chickens - Commercially grown broilers-fryers and other young immature birds such as roasters and capons.

Mature chickens - Fowl from breeder and market egg flocks and stags and cocks.

Fryer-roaster turkeys - Young immature birds, usually under 16 weeks of age.

Young turkeys (mature) - Young birds grown to a matured market age, usually 5 to 7 months.

Old turkeys (breeders) - Fully matured birds held for egg production, usually over 15 months of age.

Ducks - Includes all ducks regardless of age and weight.

Other poultry - Includes all other ready-to-cook products which bear the U.S.D.A. Inspected for Wholesomeness legend.
