

# POULTRY SLAUGHTER



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August 1979

LIVE WEIGHT POULTRY INSPECTION increased 11 percent from August 1978 to 1.85 billion pounds during August 1979, and 9 percent above July 1979, according to the Crop Reporting Board.

Inspections included 1.42 billion pounds of young chickens, up 10 percent from August 1978 and 6 percent above July 1979; 83.0 million pounds of mature chickens, a 37 percent increase from last year and 24 percent above last month. Turkey inspections totaled 338 million pounds, up 8 percent from a year earlier and 23 percent above July 1979. Duck inspection at 11.4 million pounds, increased 12 percent from August 1978 and 5 percent from July 1979.

POULTRY CERTIFIED WHOLESOME in August totaled 1.35 billion pounds ready-to-cook weight, up 11 percent from August 1978 and 10 percent above July 1979. Of the August 1979 total, 78 percent was chilled and 22 percent frozen.

FURTHER PROCESSED poultry totaled 301 million pounds ready-to-cook weight, up 7 percent from August 1978 and 26 percent above July 1979.

CUT-UP PACKAGED totaled 430 million pounds ready-to-cook weight, up 10 percent from August 1978 and 16 percent above July 1979.

ANTE-MORTEM CONDEMNATIONS during August 1979 were 11.2 million pounds live weight. This was 0.60 percent of quantities inspected, compared with 0.64 percent a year ago. POST-MORTEM CONDEMNATIONS were 34.9 million pounds (N.Y.D. weight). This was 2.11 percent of quantities inspected, compared with 2.02 percent in August 1978.

POULTRY SLAUGHTERED (including that slaughtered in non-federally inspected plants) during August was 1.36 billion pounds ready-to-cook weight, up 10 percent from both August 1978 and July 1979.

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DEFINITIONS

- YOUNG CHICKENS - Commercially grown broilers-fryers and other young immature birds such as roasters and capons.
- MATURE CHICKENS - Fowl from breeder and market egg flocks and stags and cocks.
- FRYER-ROASTER TURKEYS - Young immature birds, usually under 16 weeks of age.
- YOUNG TURKEYS (MATURE) - Young birds grown to a matured market age, usually 5 to 7 months.
- OLD TURKEYS (BREEDERS) - Fully matured birds held for egg production, usually over 15 months of age.
- DUCKS - Includes all ducks regardless of age and weight.
- OTHER POULTRY - Includes all other ready-to-cook products which bear the U.S.D.A. Inspected for Wholesomeness legend.
