LIVE WEIGHT POULTRY INSPECTIONS totaled 1.64 billion pounds during July, down 3 percent from July 1979, but virtually the same as June 1980, according to the Crop Reporting Board.

Inspections included 1.28 billion pounds of young chickens, down 5 percent from July 1979 and 3 percent less than June 1980; 51.9 million pounds of mature chickens, down 22 percent from July 1979 and 20 percent below June 1980. Turkey inspections totaled 302 million pounds, up 10 percent from July 1979 and 18 percent more than June 1980. Duck inspections totaled 9.98 million pounds, down 8 percent from the comparable month a year earlier but 6 percent above June 1980.

POULTRY CERTIFIED WHOLESOME totaled 1.21 billion pounds, down 2 percent from July 1979, but up fractionally from June 1980. The July 1980 percentage breakdown was 78 percent chilled and 22 percent frozen.

FURTHER PROCESSED poultry totaled 299 million pounds ready-to-cook weight, 25 percent above July a year ago and 11 percent more than June 1980.

CUT-UP PACKAGED poultry products totaled 453 million pounds, 22 percent more than July 1979, and 6 percent above June 1980.

ANTE-MORTEM CONDEMNATIONS during July 1980 were 9.81 million pounds live weight. Percent of quantities inspected equaled 0.59 compared with 0.64 percent during July a year earlier. POST-MORTEM CONDEMNATIONS were 28.3 million pounds (N.Y.D. Weight), 1.92 percent of quantities inspected, compared with 2.09 percent during July 1979.

POULTRY SLAUGHTERED (including that slaughtered in non-federally inspected plants) was 1.21 billion pounds ready-to-cook weight, 2 percent above July 1979, but fractionally above June 1980.

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Definitions

Young chickens - Commercially grown broilers-fryers and other young immature birds such as roasters and capons.

Mature chickens - Fowl from breeder and market egg flocks and stags and cocks.

Fryer-roasters turkeys - Young immature birds, usually under 16 weeks of age.

Young turkeys (mature) - Young birds grown to a matured market age, usually 5 to 7 months.

Old turkeys (breeders) - Fully matured birds held for egg production, usually over 15 months of age.

Ducks - Includes all ducks regardless of age and weight.

Other poultry - Includes all other ready-to-cook products which bear the U.S.D.A. Inspected for Wholesomeness legend.
