

# POULTRY SLAUGHTER



Statistical Reporting  
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LIVE WEIGHT POULTRY INSPECTIONS equaled the 1.80 billion pounds (817 thousand metric tons) during July 1981, an increase of 10 percent from July 1980 and fractionally above June 1981, according to the Crop Reporting Board.

Inspections included 1.41 billion pounds (640 thousand metric tons) of young chickens, up 10 percent from July 1980 but down 1 percent from June 1981; 63.0 million pounds (28.6 thousand metric tons) of mature chickens, an increase of 22 percent from July 1980 but a 15 percent decline from June 1981. Turkey inspections totaled 316 million pounds (143 thousand metric tons), 4 percent above a year earlier and 12 percent above June 1981. Duck inspections of 10.5 million pounds (4760 metric tons) were up 5 percent from July 1980 but 8 percent below June 1981.

POULTRY CERTIFIED WHOLESOME totaled 1.33 billion pounds (602 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight during July 1981, an increase of 10 percent from July 1980 and 1 percent above June 1981. The percentage breakdown for the July 1981 total is 77 percent chilled and 23 percent frozen.

FURTHER PROCESSED poultry totaled 304 million pounds (138 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight, up 2 percent from July 1980 and 6 percent from June 1981.

CUT-UP PACKAGED poultry products totaled 464 million pounds (211 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight, 2 percent above July 1980 but 2 percent below June 1981.

ANTE-MORTEM CONDEMNATIONS during July totaled 9.37 million pounds (4250 metric tons) live weight. Percent of quantities inspected equaled 0.52 compared with 0.59 percent for July 1980. POST-MORTEM CONDEMNATIONS were 28.2 million pounds (12.8 thousand metric tons) (N.Y.D. Weight). This was 1.75 percent of quantities inspected compared with 1.92 percent in July 1980.

POULTRY SLAUGHTER (including slaughter in non-federally inspected plants) during July 1981 was 1.34 billion pounds (606 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight, up 10 percent from July 1980 and 1 percent from June 1981.

Definitions

Young chickens - Commercially grown broilers-fryers and other young immature birds such as roasters and capons.

Mature chickens - Fowl from breeder and market egg flocks and stags and cocks.

Fryer-roaster turkeys - Young immature birds, usually under 16 weeks of age.

Young turkeys (mature) - Young birds grown to a matured market age, usually 5 to 7 months.

Old turkeys (breeders) - Fully matured birds held for egg production, usually over 15 months of age.

Ducks - Includes all ducks regardless of age and weight.

Other poultry - Includes all other ready-to-cook products which bear the U.S.D.A. Inspected for Wholesomeness legend.

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The data presented in this report were compiled from reports collected by the Meat and Poultry Inspection Program, Food Safety and Inspection Service.
