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POULTRY SLAUGHTER



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LIVE WEIGHT POULTRY INSPECTIONS equaled 1.76 billion pounds (799 thousand metric tons) during August 1981, an increase of 11 percent from August 1980, but 2 percent below July 1981, according to the Crop Reporting Board.

Inspections included 1.36 billion pounds (617 thousand metric tons) of young chickens, up 9 percent from August 1980, but down 4 percent from July 1981; 63.9 million pounds (29.0 thousand metric tons) of mature chickens, an increase of 29 percent from August 1980 and 1 percent from July 1981. Turkey inspections totaled 325 million pounds (147 thousand metric tons), 14 percent above a year earlier and 3 percent above July 1981. Duck inspections of 10.3 million pounds (4670 metric tons) were up 13 percent from August 1980, but 2 percent below July 1981.

POULTRY CERTIFIED WHOLESOME totaled 1.30 billion pounds (589 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight during August 1981, an increase of 11 percent from August 1980, but 2 percent below July 1981. The percentage breakdown for the August 1981 total is 77 percent chilled and 23 percent frozen.

FURTHER PROCESSED poultry totaled 326 million pounds (148 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight, up 10 percent from August 1980 and 7 percent from July 1981.

CUT-UP PACKAGED poultry products totaled 466 million pounds (211 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight, up 4 percent from August 1980 and fractionally above July 1981.

ANTE-MORTEM CONDEMNATIONS during August totaled 6.36 million pounds (2890 metric tons) live weight. Percent of quantities inspected equaled 0.36 compared with 0.53 percent for August 1980. POST-MORTEM CONDEMNATIONS were 27.2 million pounds (12.4 thousand metric tons) (N.Y.D Weight). This was 1.72 percent of quantities inspected compared with 1.94 percent during August 1980.

POULTRY SLAUGHTER (including slaughter in non-federally inspected plants) during August 1981 was 1.31 billion pounds (592 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight, up 12 percent from August 1980 but 2 percent below July 1981.

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Definitions

Young chickens - Commercially grown broilers-fryers and other young immature birds such as roasters and capons.

Mature chickens - Fowl from breeder and market egg flocks and stags and cocks.

Fryer-roaster turkeys - Young immature birds, usually under 16 weeks of age.

Young turkeys (mature) - Young birds grown to a matured market age, usually 5 to 7 months.

Old turkeys (breeders) - Fully matured birds held for egg production, usually over 15 months of age.

Ducks - Includes all ducks regardless of age and weight.

Other poultry - Includes all other ready-to-cook products which bear the U.S.D.A. Inspected for Wholesomeness legend.
