

POULTRY SLAUGHTER



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Live Weight Poultry Inspections equaled 1.85 billion pounds (840 thousands metric tons) during October 1981, an increase of 3 percent from September 1980 and 1 percent more than September 1981, according to the Crop Reporting Board.

Inspections included 1.40 billion pounds (636 thousand metric tons) of young chickens, up 3 percent from October 1980 and virtually unchanged from September 1981; 70.4 million pounds (31.9 thousand metric tons) of mature chickens, a decrease of 12 percent from October 1980 and 1 percent below September 1981. Turkey inspections totaled 366 million pounds (166 thousand metric tons), 7 percent above both a year earlier and September 1981. Duck inspections of 10.2 million pounds (4630 metric tons) were up 3 percent from October 1980, but 2 percent below September 1981.

Poultry Certified Wholesome totaled 1.37 billion pounds (621 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight during October 1981, an increase of 4 percent from October 1980 and 2 percent above September 1981. The percentage breakdown for the October 1981 total is 76 percent chilled and 24 percent frozen.

Further Processed poultry totaled 340 million pounds (154 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight, a decrease of 6 percent from October 1980, but 3 percent above September 1981.

Cut-Up Packaged poultry products totaled 479 million pounds (217 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight, a decrease of 4 percent from October 1980 and 3 percent below September 1981.

Ante-Mortem Condemnations during October totaled 4.94 million pounds (2240 metric tons) live weight. Condemnations as a percent of quantities inspected was 0.26 for both October 1980 and 1981. Post-Mortem Condemnations were 28.3 million pounds (12.9 thousand metric tons) (N.Y.D. Weight). This was 1.70 percent of quantities inspected compared with 1.85 percent during October 1980.

Definitions

Young chickens - Commercially grown broilers-fryers and other young immature birds such as roasters and capons.

Mature chickens - Fowl from breeder and market egg flocks and stags and cocks.

Fryer-roaster turkeys - Young immature birds, usually under 16 weeks of age.

Young turkeys (mature) - Young birds grown to a matured market age, usually 5 to 7 months.

Old turkeys (breeders) - Fully matured birds held for egg production, usually over 15 months of age.

Ducks - Includes all ducks regardless of age and weight.

Other poultry - Includes all other ready-to-cook products which bear the U.S.D.A. Inspected for Wholesomeness legend.
