

# POULTRY SLAUGHTER



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Live Weight Poultry Inspections totaled 1.60 billion pounds (725 thousand metric tons) during November 1981, an increase of 10 percent from November 1980, but 14 percent below October 1981, according to the Crop Reporting Board.

Inspections included 1.18 billion pounds (537 thousand metric tons) of young chickens, up 9 percent from November 1980, but 16 percent below October 1981; 54.7 million pounds (24.8 thousand metric tons) of mature chickens, an increase of 2 percent from November 1980, but 22 percent below October 1981. Turkey inspections totaled 348 million pounds (158 thousand metric tons), 14 percent above November 1980, but 5 percent below October 1981. Duck inspections of 9.54 million pounds (4,330 metric tons) were up 21 percent from November 1980, but 7 percent below October 1981.

Poultry Certified Wholesome totaled 1.18 billion pounds (537 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight during November 1981, an increase of 11 percent from November 1980, but 13 percent below October 1981. The percentage breakdown for the November 1981 total is 77 percent chilled and 23 percent frozen.

Further Processed poultry totaled 325 million pounds (147 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight, an increase of 20 percent from November 1980, but 6 percent below October 1981.

Cut-Up Packaged poultry products totaled 448 million pounds (203 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight, an increase of 9 percent from November 1980, but 7 percent below October 1981.

Ante-Mortem Condemnations during November totaled 4.11 million pounds (1870 metric tons) live weight. Condemnations as a percent of quantities inspected was 0.25 compared with 0.28 for November 1980. Post-Mortem Condemnations were 24.8 million pounds (11.3 thousand metric tons) (N.Y.D. Weight). This was 1.73 percent of quantities inspected compared with 1.85 percent during November 1980.

Definitions

Young chickens - Commercially grown broilers-fryers and other young immature birds such as roasters and capons.

Mature chickens - Fowl from breeder and market egg flocks and stags and cocks.

Fryer-roaster turkeys - Young immature birds, usually under 16 weeks of age.

Young turkeys (mature) - Young birds grown to a matured market age, usually 5 to 7 months.

Old turkeys (breeders) - Fully matured birds held for egg production, usually over 15 months of age.

Ducks - Includes all ducks regardless of age and weight.

Other poultry - Includes all other ready-to-cook products which bear the U.S.D.A. Inspected for Wholesomeness legend.
