Live Weight Poultry Inspections totaled 1.67 billion pounds (755 thousand metric tons) during December 1981, an increase of 3 percent from December 1980, according to the Crop Reporting Board.

Inspections included 1.32 billion pounds (600 thousand metric tons) of young chickens, up 3 percent from December 1980, and 74.0 million pounds (33.6 thousand metric tons) of mature chickens, an increase of 3 percent from December 1980. Turkey inspection totaled 258 million pounds (117 thousand metric tons), 7 percent above December 1980. Duck inspections of 10.4 million pounds (4700 metric tons) were up 16 percent from December 1980.

Poultry Certified Wholesome totaled 1.22 billion pounds (554 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight, during December 1981, an increase of 4 percent from December 1980. The percentage breakdown for the December 1981 total is 81 percent chilled and 19 percent frozen.

Further Processed poultry totaled 284 million pounds (129 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight, a decrease of 3 percent from December 1980.

Cut - Up Packaged poultry products totaled 469 million pounds (213 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight, an increase of 1 percent from December 1980.

Ante-Mortem Condemnations during December totaled 5.50 million pounds (2490 metric tons) live weight. Condemnations as a percent of quantities inspected was 0.33 compared with 0.32 for December 1980. Post-Mortem Condemnations were 27.0 million pounds (12.3 thousand metric tons)(N.Y.D. Weight). This was 1.80 percent of quantities inspected compared with 2.07 percent during December 1980.

Notice: New summary procedures, developed by Federal Safety Inspection Service, were used to compile data in this report. These procedures allow the inclusion of late reports or other corrections to be included in historic data. Generally, historic data in this report will show minor increases from data first published.

Definitions Used to Report Federally Inspected Slaughter.

Young chickens - Commercially grown broilers-fryers and other young immature birds such as roasters and capons.

Mature chickens - Fowl from breeder and market egg flocks and stags and cocks.

Fryer-roaster turkeys - Young immature birds, usually under 16 weeks of age.

Young turkeys (mature) - Young birds grown to a matured market age, usually 5 to 7 months.

Old turkeys (breeders) - Fully matured birds held for egg production, usually over 15 months of age.

Ducks - Includes all ducks regardless of age and weight.

Other poultry - Includes all other ready-to-cook products which bear the U.S.D.A. Inspected for Wholesomeness legend.
