

POULTRY SLAUGHTER



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January 1982

Live Weight Poultry Inspections totaled 1.49 billion pounds (677 thousand metric tons) during January 1982, a decrease of 8 percent from January 1981, according to the Crop Reporting Board.

Inspections included 1.25 billion pounds (566 thousand metric tons) of young chickens, and 72.0 million pounds (32.6 thousand metric tons) of mature chickens, decreases of 7 and 18 percent from January 1981, respectively. Turkey inspection totaled 164 million pounds (74.5 thousand metric tons), 9 percent below January 1981. Duck inspections of 8.43 million pounds (3820 metric tons) were up 11 percent from January 1981.

Poultry Certified Wholesome totaled 1.09 billion pounds (493 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight during January 1982, a decrease of 7 percent from January 1981. The percentage breakdown for the January 1982 total is 83 percent chilled and 17 percent frozen.

Further Processed poultry totaled 248 million pounds (113 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight, a decrease of 14 percent from January 1981.

Cut-Up Packaged poultry products totaled 439 million pounds (199 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight, a decrease of 7 percent from January 1981.

Ante-Mortem Condemnations during January totaled 7.34 million pounds (3330 metric tons) live weight. Condemnations as a percent of quantities inspected was 0.49 compared with 0.40 percent for January 1981. Post-Mortem Condemnations were 26.0 million pounds (11.8 thousand metric tons) (N.Y.D. Weight). This was 1.94 percent of quantities inspected compared with 2.26 percent during January 1981.

NOTICE: New summary procedures, developed by Federal Safety Inspection Service, were used to compile data in this report. Procedures allow late reports or other corrections to be included in January 1981 data.

Publication of revised monthly data for 1980 and 1981 is planned for the April 1 release. U.S. level data will include the number inspected, live weight inspected, pounds certified (RTC), condemnations, and poultry for further processing for chickens and turkeys.

Definitions Used to Report Federally Inspected Slaughter.

Young chickens - Commercially grown broilers-fryers and other young immature birds such as roasters and capons.

Mature chickens - Fowl from breeder and market egg flocks and stags and cocks.

Fryer-roaster turkeys - Young immature birds, usually under 16 weeks of age.

Young turkeys (mature) - Young birds grown to a matured market age, usually 5 to 7 months.

Old turkeys (breeders) - Fully matured birds held for egg production, usually over 15 months of age.

Ducks - Includes all ducks regardless of age and weight.

Other poultry - Includes all other ready-to-cook products which bear the U.S.D.A. Inspected for Wholesomeness legend.
