

POULTRY SLAUGHTER



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Live Weight Poultry Inspections totaled 1.47 billion pounds (666 thousand metric tons) during February 1982, a 3 percent increase from February 1981, according to the Crop Reporting Board.

Inspections included 1.24 billion pounds (561 thousand metric tons) of young chickens, an increase of 4 percent from the previous year. Year-to-date accumulated inspections for young chickens were 1 percent behind the 1981 pace. Mature chickens totaled 66.6 million pounds (30.2 thousand metric tons), 15 percent below both February 1981 and the accumulated year-to-date inspections. Turkey inspections at 156 million pounds (70.6 thousand metric tons) were up 2 percent from February 1981. However, the 1982 accumulated-to-date inspections were 3 percent below the 1981 pace. Duck inspections of 8.62 million pounds (3910 metric tons) were up 25 percent from a year earlier. Accumulated year-to-date inspections were up 18 percent from 1981.

Poultry Certified Wholesome totaled 1.07 billion pounds (486 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight during February 1982, up 3 percent from February 1981. The percentage breakdown for the February 1982 total is 84 percent chilled and 16 percent frozen.

Further Processed poultry totaled 259 million pounds (118 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight, a decrease of 4 percent from February 1981.

Cut-Up Packaged poultry products totaled 443 million pounds (201 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight, up 6 percent from February 1981.

Ante-Mortem Condemnations during February was 5.65 million pounds (2560 metric tons) live weight. Condemnations as a percent of quantities inspected was 0.38 compared with 0.43 percent for February 1981. Post-Mortem Condemnations were 24.3 million pounds (11.0 thousand metric tons) (N.Y.D. Weight). Quantities condemned equaled 1.84 percent compared with 2.17 percent during February 1981.

Annual Total Poultry Slaughter (including slaughter in non-federally inspected plants) during 1981 was 15.2 billion pounds (6.91 million metric tons) ready-to-cook weight, up 6 percent from 1980. Federal inspection covered 99 percent of the annual ready-to-cook poundage.

Definitions Used to Report Federally Inspected Slaughter:

Young chickens - Commercially grown broilers-fryers and other young immature birds such as roasters and capons.

Mature chickens - Fowl from breeder and market egg flocks and stags and cocks.

Fryer-roaster turkeys - Young immature birds, usually under 16 weeks of age.

Young turkeys (mature) - Young birds grown to a matured market age, usually 5 to 7 months.

Old turkeys (breeders) - Fully matured birds held for egg production, usually over 15 months of age.

Ducks - Includes all ducks regardless of age and weight.

Other poultry - Includes all other ready-to-cook products which bear the U.S.D.A. Inspected for Wholesomeness legend.
