

# POULTRY SLAUGHTER

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May 1982

Live Weight Poultry Inspections totaled 1.64 billion pounds (745 thousand metric tons) during May 1982, a decrease of 5 percent from May 1981 and 1 percent below April 1982, according to the Crop Reporting Board.

*Inspections included 1.36 billion pounds (617 thousand metric tons) of young chickens, down 3 percent from May 1981 and 2 percent below April 1982; 71.1 million pounds (32.3 thousand metric tons) of mature chickens, a decrease of 9 percent from May 1981 and 17 percent below April 1982. Turkey inspections totaled 200 million pounds (90.8 thousand metric tons), 11 percent below May 1981, but 10 percent above April 1982. Duck inspections of 10.4 million pounds (4700 metric tons) were up 6 percent from May 1981, but virtually unchanged from April 1982.*

Poultry Certified Wholesome totaled 1.21 billion pounds (548 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight during May 1982, a decrease of 4 percent from May 1981 and 1 percent below April 1982. The percentage breakdown for the May 1982 total is 84 percent chilled and 16 percent frozen.

Ante-Mortem Condemnations during May totaled 4.51 million pounds (2050 metric tons) live weight. Condemnations as a percent of quantities inspected was 0.27 percent compared with 0.30 percent for May 1981. Post-Mortem Condemnations were 22.2 million pounds (10.1 thousand metric tons) (N.Y.D. Weight). Quantities condemned equaled 1.50 percent of quantities inspected compared with 1.71 percent during May 1981.

Further Processed poultry totaled 300 million pounds (136 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight. Cut-Up packaged poultry products totaled 499 million pounds (226 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight.

Definitions Used to Report Federally Inspected Slaughter.

Young chickens - Commercially grown broilers-fryers and other young immature birds such as roasters and capons.

Mature chickens - Fowl from breeder and market egg flocks and stags and cocks.

Fryer-roaster turkeys - Young immature birds, usually under 16 weeks of age.

Young turkeys (mature) - Young birds grown to a matured market age, usually 5 to 7 months.

Old turkeys (breeders) - Fully matured birds held for egg production, usually over 15 months of age.

Ducks - Includes all ducks regardless of age and weight.

Other poultry - Includes all other ready-to-cook products which bear the U.S.D.A. Inspected for Wholesomeness legend.



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
