Live Weight Poultry Inspections have a preliminary total of 1.85 billion pounds (839 thousand metric tons) during August 1982, an increase of 4 percent from August 1981 and 5 percent above July 1982, according to the Crop Reporting Board.

Inspections included 1.43 billion pounds (649 thousand metric tons) of young chickens, an increase of 4 percent from August 1981 and 2 percent above July 1982; 74.6 million pounds (33.9 thousand metric tons) of mature chickens, an increase of 13 percent from August 1981 and 16 percent above July 1982. Turkey inspections totaled 331 million pounds (150 thousand metric tons), virtually unchanged from August 1981, but 16 percent above July 1982. Duck inspections of 10.9 million pounds (4940 metric tons) were 3 percent above August 1981 and 7 percent above July 1982.

Poultry Certified Wholesome during August 1982 totaled 1.37 billion pounds (621 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight, an increase of 4 percent from August 1981 and 5 percent above July 1982. The percentage breakdown for August 1982 total is 80 percent chilled and 20 percent frozen.

Ante-Mortem Condemnations during August totaled 6.51 million pounds (2950 metric tons) live weight. Condemnations were 0.35 percent of the quantity inspected compared with 0.36 percent for August 1981. Post-Mortem Condemnations were 25.3 million pounds (11.5 thousand metric tons) (N.Y.D. Weight), 1.52 percent of quantities inspected compared with 1.72 percent during August 1981.

Further Processed poultry totaled 381 million pounds (173 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight. Cut-up packaged poultry products totaled 543 million pounds (246 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight.
