

POULTRY SLAUGHTER



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Live Weight Poultry Inspections have a preliminary total of 1.84 billion pounds (835 thousand metric tons) during September 1982, a decrease of 1 percent from both September 1981 and August 1982, according to the Crop Reporting Board.

Inspections included 1.42 billion pounds (646 thousand metric tons) of young chickens, virtually unchanged from September 1981, but 1 percent below August 1982; 72.2 million pounds (32.7 thousand metric tons) of mature chickens, an increase of 1 percent from September 1981, but 4 percent below August 1982. Turkey inspections totaled 334 million pounds (152 thousand metric tons), 3 percent below September 1981, but 1 percent above August 1982. Duck inspections of 10.8 million pounds (4910 metric tons) were 4 percent above September 1981, but 1 percent below August 1982.

Poultry Certified Wholesome during September 1982 totaled 1.36 billion pounds (619 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight, down 1 percent from August 1982. The percentage breakdown for September 1982 total is 79 percent chilled and 21 percent frozen.

Ante-Mortem Condemnations during September totaled 5.19 million pounds (2350 metric tons) live weight. Condemnations were 0.28 percent of the quantity inspected compared with 0.31 percent for September 1981. Post-Mortem Condemnations were 25.8 million pounds (11.7 thousand metric tons) (N.Y.D. Weight), 1.56 percent of quantities inspected compared with 1.69 percent during September 1981.

Further Processed poultry totaled 410 million pounds (186 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight. Cut-up packaged poultry products totaled 554 million pounds (251 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight.

Young chickens - Commercially grown broilers-fryers and other young immature birds such as roasters and capons.

Mature chickens - Fowl from breeder and market egg flocks and stags and cocks.

Fryer-roaster turkeys - Young immature birds, usually under 16 weeks of age.

Young turkeys (mature) - Young birds grown to a matured market age, usually 5 to 7 months.

Old turkeys (breeders) - Fully matured birds held for egg production, usually over 15 months of age.

Ducks - Includes all ducks regardless of age and weight.

Other poultry - Includes all other ready-to-cook products which bear the U.S.D.A. Inspected for Wholesomeness legend.

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
