Live Weight Poultry Inspections have a preliminary total of 1.79 billion pounds (813 thousand metric tons) during October 1982, a decrease of 4 percent from both October 1981 and 3 percent below September 1982, according to the Crop Reporting Board.

Inspections included 1.37 billion pounds (621 thousand metric tons) of young chickens, 3 percent below October 1981 and 4 percent below September 1982; 66.5 million pounds (30.2 thousand metric tons) of mature chickens, a decrease of 6 percent from October 1981 and 8 percent below September 1982. Turkey inspections totaled 343 million pounds (155 thousand metric tons), 6 percent below October 1981, but 3 percent above September 1982. Duck inspections of 10.4 million pounds (4730 metric tons) were 2 percent above October 1981, but 4 percent below September 1982.

Poultry Certified Wholesome during October 1982 totaled 1.33 billion pounds (601 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight, down 4 percent from October 1981 and down 3 percent September 1982. The percentage breakdown for October 1982 total is 78 percent chilled and 22 percent frozen.

Ante-Mortem Condemnations during October totaled 4.79 million pounds (2170 metric tons) live weight. Condemnations were 0.26 percent of the quantity inspected for both October 1981 and 1982. Post-Mortem Condemnations were 24.8 million pounds (11.3 thousand metric tons) (N.Y.D. Weight), 1.54 percent of quantities inspected compared with 1.70 percent during October 1981.

Further Processed poultry totaled 380 million pounds (172 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight. Cut-up packaged poultry products totaled 565 million pounds (256 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight.

Definitions Used to Report Federally Inspected Slaughter:

Young chickens - Commercially grown broilers-fryers and other young immature birds such as roasters and capons.

Mature chickens - Fowl from breeder and market egg flocks and stags and cocks.

Fryer-roaster turkeys - Young immature birds, usually under 16 weeks of age.

Young turkeys (mature) - Young birds grown to a matured market age, usually 5 to 7 months.

Old turkeys (breeders) - Fully matured birds held for egg production, usually over 15 months of age.

Ducks - Includes all ducks regardless of age and weight.

Other poultry - Includes all other ready-to-cook products which bear the U.S.D.A. Inspected for Wholesomeness legend.
