Live Weight Poultry Inspections have a preliminary total of 1.71 billion pounds (777 thousand metric tons) during November 1982, an increase of 6 percent from November 1981 but 5 percent below October 1982, according to the Crop Reporting Board.

Inspections included 1.27 billion pounds (577 thousand metric tons) of young chickens, 7 percent above November 1981 but 8 percent below October 1982; 66.9 million pounds (30.3 thousand metric tons) of mature chickens, an increase of 20 percent from November 1981 but 1 percent below October 1982. Turkey inspections totaled 362 million pounds (164 thousand metric tons), 3 percent above November 1981, and 5 percent above October 1982. Duck inspections of 11.1 million pounds (5010 metric tons) were 15 percent above November 1981, and 5 percent above October 1982.

Poultry Certified Wholesome during November 1982 totaled 1.26 billion pounds (572 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight, 6 percent above November 1981 but down 6 percent from October 1982. The percentage breakdown for November 1982 total is 78 percent chilled and 22 percent frozen.

Ante-Mortem Condemnations during November totaled 4.67 million pounds (2120 metric tons) live weight. Condemnations were 0.27 percent of the quantity inspected for November 1982 compared with 0.25 percent for November 1981. Post-Mortem Condemnations were 25.1 million pounds (11.4 thousand metric tons) (N.Y.D. Weight), 1.63 percent of quantities inspected compared with 1.73 percent during November 1981.

Further Processed poultry totaled 336 million pounds (153 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight. Cut-up packaged poultry products totaled 444 million pounds (201 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight.

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Definitions Used to Report Federally Inspected Slaughter:

Young chickens - Commercially grown broilers-fryers and other young immature birds such as roasters and capons.

Mature chickens - Fowl from breeder and market egg flocks and stags and cocks.

Fryer-roaster turkeys - Young immature birds, usually under 16 weeks of age.

Young turkeys (mature) - Young birds grown to a matured market age, usually 5 to 7 months.

Old turkeys (breeders) - Fully matured birds held for egg production, usually over 15 months of age.

Ducks - Includes all ducks regardless of age and weight.

Other poultry - Includes all other ready-to-cook products which bear the U.S.D.A. Inspected for Wholesomeness legend.
