The Preliminary total of Live Weight Poultry Inspections was 1.85 billion pounds (841 thousand metric tons) for June 1983, according to the Crop Reporting Board.

Inspections included 1.49 billion pounds (676 thousand metric tons) of young chickens, 80.3 percent of the total pounds inspected.

Poultry Certified Wholesome during June 1983 was 1.37 billion pounds (621 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight. New totals for May 1983 show 1.33 billion pounds (602 thousand metric tons) were inspected.

Ante-Mortem Condemnations during June 1983 totaled 5.84 million pounds (2650 metric tons). Condemnations were 0.31 percent of the live weight inspected compared with 0.29 percent for June a year ago. Post-Mortem Condemnations were 24.6 million pounds (11.2 thousand metric tons) (N.Y.D. Weight), 1.48 percent of the quantities inspected compared with 1.44 percent in June 1982.

Further Processed poultry totaled 344 million pounds (156 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight. Cut-up packaged poultry totaled 558 million pounds (253 thousand metric tons).

Young turkeys (mature) - Young birds grown to a matured market age, usually 5 to 7 months.

Old turkeys (breeders) - Fully matured birds held for egg production, usually over 15 months of age.

Ducks - Includes all ducks regardless of age and weight.

Other poultry - Includes all other ready-to-cook products which bear the U.S.D.A. Inspected for Wholesomeness legend.
