The preliminary total of Live Weight Poultry Inspections was 1.67 billion pounds (758 thousand metric tons) for July 1983, according to the Crop Reporting Board.

Inspections included 1.32 billion pounds (598 thousand metric tons) of young chickens, 78.9 percent of the total pounds inspected.

Poultry Certified Wholesome during July 1983 was 1.24 billion pounds (563 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight. New totals for June 1983 show 1.41 billion pounds (639 thousand metric tons) were inspected.

Ante-Mortem Condemnations during July 1983 totaled 6.84 million pounds (3100 metric tons). Condemnations were 0.40 percent of the live weight inspected compared with 0.37 percent for July a year ago. Post-Mortem Condemnations were 22.0 million pounds (9990 metric tons) (N.Y.D. Weight), 1.47 percent of the quantities inspected for both July 1983 and 1982.

Further Processed poultry totaled 345 million pounds (157 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight. Cut-up packaged poultry totaled 516 million pounds (234 thousand metric tons).

Fryer-roaster turkeys - Young immature birds, usually under 16 weeks of age.

Young turkeys (mature) - Young birds grown to a matured market age, usually 5 to 7 months.

Old turkeys (breeders) - Fully matured birds held for egg production, usually over 15 months of age.

Ducks - Includes all ducks regardless of age and weight.

Other poultry - Includes all other ready-to-cook products which bear the U.S.D.A. Inspected for Wholesomeness legend.
