The preliminary total of Live Weight Poultry Inspections was 1.91 billion pounds (868 thousand metric tons) for August 1983, according to the Crop Reporting Board.

Inspections included 1.49 billion pounds (677 thousand metric tons) of young chickens, 4 percent above August 1982 and 13 percent above July 1983; 65.8 million pounds (29.9 thousand metric tons) of mature chicken, a decrease of 12 percent from August 1982 but 10 percent more than July 1983. Turkey inspections totaled 342 million pounds (155 thousand metric tons), 3 percent above a year ago and 21 percent above July 1983. Duck inspections of 12.0 million pounds (5430 metric tons) were 10 percent above August last year and 15 percent above last month.

Poultry Certified Wholesome during August 1983 was 1.42 billion pounds (645 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight. Revised totals for July 1983 show 1.25 billion pounds (565 thousand metric tons) were inspected.

Ante-Mortem Condemnations during August 1983 totaled 7.17 million pounds (3250 metric tons). Condemnations were 0.37 percent of the live weight inspected compared with 0.35 percent for August a year ago. Post-Mortem Condemnations were 26.0 million pounds (11.8 thousand metric tons) (N.Y.D. Weight), 1.51 percent of the quantities inspected for August 1983 compared with 1.52 percent a year earlier.

Further Processed poultry totaled 383 million pounds (174 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight. Cut-up packaged poultry totaled 572 million pounds (259 thousand metric tons).

Young turkeys (mature) - Young birds grown to a matured market age, usually 5 to 7 months.

Old turkeys (breeders) - Fully matured birds held for egg production, usually over 15 months of age.

Ducks - Includes all ducks regardless of age and weight.

Other poultry - Includes all other ready-to-cook products which bear the U.S.D.A. Inspected for Wholesomeness legend.
