The preliminary total of Live Weight Poultry Inspections was 1.69 billion pounds (767 thousand metric tons) for November 1983, according to the Crop Reporting Board.

Inspections included 1.27 billion pounds (576 thousand metric tons) of young chickens, 50.1 million pounds (22.7 thousand metric tons) of mature chickens, 359 million pounds (163 thousand metric tons) of turkeys and 10.8 million pounds (4900 metric tons) of ducks.

Poultry Certified Wholesome during November 1983 was 1.26 billion pounds (571 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight. Updated totals for October 1983 show that 1.37 billion pounds (620 thousand metric tons) were certified.

Ante-Mortem Condemnations during November 1983 totaled 4.45 million pounds (2020 metric tons). Condemnations were .26 percent of the live weight inspected compared with .27 percent during November a year ago. Post-Mortem Condemnations were 23.6 million pounds (10.7 thousand metric tons) (N.Y.D. Weight), 1.55 percent of the quantities inspected compared with 1.62 percent a year earlier.

Further Processed poultry totaled 354 million pounds (161 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight. Cut-up packaged poultry totaled 487 million pounds (221 thousand metric tons).

Ducks - Includes all ducks regardless of age and weight.

Other poultry - Includes all other ready-to-cook products which bear the U.S.D.A. Inspected for Wholesomeness legend.
