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The preliminary total of Live Weight Poultry Inspections was 1.85 billion pounds (840 thousand metric tons) for June 1984, according to the Crop Reporting Board.

Inspections included 1.49 billion pounds (676 thousand metric tons) of young chickens, 75.4 million pounds (34.2 thousand metric tons) of mature chickens, 275 million pounds (125 thousand metric tons) of turkeys and 10.8 million pounds (4920 metric tons) of ducks.

Poultry Certified Wholesome during June 1984 was 1.37 billion pounds (621 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight. Updated totals for May 1984 show that 1.44 billion pounds (654 thousand metric tons) were certified.

Ante-Mortem Condemnations during June 1984 totaled 7.46 million pounds (3380 metric tons). Condemnations were 0.40 percent of the live weight inspected compared with 0.31 percent during June a year ago. Post-Mortem Condemnations were 25.2 million pounds (11.4 thousand metric tons) (N.Y. Dressed Weight), 1.51 percent of the quantities inspected compared with 1.48 percent a year earlier.

Further Processed poultry totaled 401 million pounds (182 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight. Cut-Up packaged poultry totaled 628 million pounds (285 thousand metric tons).

DEFINITIONS USED TO REPORT FEDERALLY INSPECTED SLAUGHTER.

Young chickens - Commercially grown broilers-fryers and other young immature birds such as roasters and capons.

Mature chickens - Fowl from breeder and market egg flocks and stags and cocks.

Fryer-roaster turkeys - Young immature birds, usually under 16 weeks of age.

Young turkeys (mature) - Young birds grown to a matured market age, usually 5 to 7 months.

Old turkeys (breeders) - Fully matured birds held for egg production, usually over 15 months of age.

Ducks - Includes all ducks regardless of age and weight.

Other poultry - Includes all other ready-to-cook products which bear the U.S.D.A. Inspected for Wholesomeness legend.
