The preliminary total of Live Weight Poultry Inspections was 1.86 billion pounds (843 thousand metric tons) for July 1984, according to the Crop Reporting Board.

Inspections included 1.48 billion pounds (672 thousand metric tons) of young chickens, 68.9 million pounds (31.3 thousand metric tons) of mature chickens, 298 million pounds (135 thousand metric tons) of turkeys and 10.9 million pounds (4950 metric tons) of ducks.

Poultry Certified Wholesome during July 1984 was 1.37 billion pounds (621 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight. Updated totals for June show that 1.39 billion pounds (632 thousand metric tons) were certified.

Ante-Mortem Condemnations during July 1984 totaled 7.49 million pounds (3400 metric tons). Condemnations were 0.40 percent of the live weight inspected compared with 0.41 percent during July a year ago. Post-Mortem Condemnations were 26.4 million pounds (12.0 thousand metric tons) (N.Y. Dressed Weight), 1.58 percent of the quantities inspected compared with 1.47 percent a year earlier.

Further Processed poultry totaled 383 million pounds (174 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight. Cut-Up packaged poultry totaled 623 million pounds (283 thousand metric tons).

Mature chickens - Fowl from breeder and market egg flocks and stags and cocks.

Fryer-roaster turkeys - Young immature birds, usually under 16 weeks of age.

Young turkeys (mature) - Young birds grown to a matured market age, usually 5 to 7 months.

Old turkeys (breeders) - Fully matured birds held for egg production, usually over 15 months of age.

Ducks - Includes all ducks regardless of age and weight.

Other poultry - Includes all other ready-to-cook products which bear the U.S.D.A. Inspected for Wholesomeness legend.
