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The preliminary total of Live Weight Poultry Inspections was 2.14 billion pounds (970 thousand metric tons) for October 1984, according to the Crop Reporting Board.

Inspections included 1.64 billion pounds (743 thousand metric tons) of young chickens, 83.7 million pounds (38.0 thousand metric tons) of mature chickens, 402 million pounds (182 thousand metric tons) of turkeys and 12.0 million pounds (5460 metric tons) of ducks.

Poultry Certified Wholesome during October 1984 was 1.58 billion pounds (716 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight. Totals for September show that 1.32 billion pounds (601 thousand metric tons) were certified.

Ante-Mortem Condemnations during October 1984 totaled 5.83 million pounds (2640 metric tons). Condemnations were 0.27 percent of the live weight inspected compared with 0.23 percent during October a year ago. Post-Mortem Condemnations were 32.0 million pounds (14.5 thousand metric tons) (N.Y. Dressed Weight), 1.66 percent of the quantities inspected compared with 1.48 percent a year earlier.

Further Processed poultry totaled 544 million pounds (247 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight. Cut-Up packaged poultry totaled 624 million pounds (283 thousand metric tons).

DEFINITIONS USED TO REPORT FEDERALLY INSPECTED SLAUGHTER.

Young chickens - Commercially grown broilers-fryers and other young immature birds such as roasters and capons.

Mature chickens - Fowl from breeder and market egg flocks and stags and cocks.

Fryer-roaster turkeys - Young immature birds, usually under 16 weeks of age.

Young turkeys (mature) - Young birds grown to a matured market age, usually 5 to 7 months.

Old turkeys (breeders) - Fully matured birds held for egg production, usually over 15 months of age.

Ducks - Includes all ducks regardless of age and weight.

Other poultry - Includes all other ready-to-cook products which bear the U.S.D.A. Inspected for Wholesomeness legend.
