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The preliminary total of Live Weight Poultry Inspections was 1.81 billion pounds (823 thousand metric tons) for January 1985, according to the Crop Reporting Board.

Inspections included 1.52 billion pounds (688 thousand metric tons) of young chickens, 90.8 million pounds (41.2 thousand metric tons) of mature chickens, 197 million pounds (89.2 thousand metric tons) of turkeys and 10.9 million pounds (4930 metric tons) of ducks.

Poultry Certified Wholesome during January 1985 was 1.32 billion pounds (600 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight. Updated totals for December 1984 show that 1.23 billion pounds (558 thousand metric tons) were certified.

Ante-Mortem Condemnations during January 1985 totaled 8.05 million pounds (3650 metric tons). Condemnations were 0.44 percent of the live weight inspected compared with 0.40 percent during January a year ago. Post-Mortem condemnations were 30.9 million pounds (14.0 thousand metric tons) (N.Y. Dressed Weight), 1.89 percent of the quantities inspected compared with 1.72 percent a year earlier.

Further Processed poultry totaled 304 million pounds (138 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight. Cut-up poultry totaled 564 million pounds (256 thousand metric tons).

Young chickens - Commercially grown broilers-fryers and other young immature birds such as roasters and capons.

Mature chickens - Fowl from breeder and market egg flocks and stags and cocks.

Fryer-roaster turkeys - Young immature birds, usually under 16 weeks of age.

Young turkeys (mature) - Young birds grown to a matured market age, usually 5 to 7 months.

Old turkeys (breeders) - Fully matured birds held for egg production, usually over 15 months of age.

Ducks - Includes all ducks regardless of age and weight.

Other poultry - Includes all other ready-to-cook products which bear the U.S.D.A. Inspected for Wholesomeness legend.
