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The preliminary total of LIVE WEIGHT POULTRY INSPECTION was 1.90 billion pounds (860 thousand metric tons) for September 1985.

Inspections included 1.47 billion pounds (665 thousand metric tons) of young chickens, 57.8 million pounds (26.2 thousand metric tons) of mature chickens, 359 million pounds (163 thousand metric tons) of turkeys and 11.5 million pounds (5230 metric tons) of ducks.

POULTRY CERTIFIED WHOLESOME during September 1985 was 1.40 billion pounds (636 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight. Updated totals for August 1985 show that 1.56 billion pounds (707 thousand metric tons) were certified.

ANTE-MORTEM CONDEMNATIONS during September 1985 totaled 6.12 million pounds (2770 metric tons). Condemnations were 0.32 percent of the live weight inspected, compared with 0.30 percent during September a year ago. POST-MORTEM CONDEMNATIONS, totaling 29.5 million pounds (13.4 thousand metric tons) (N.Y. Dressed Weight), were 1.73 percent of the quantities inspected compared with 1.61 percent during September 1984.

FURTHER PROCESSED poultry totaled 434 million pounds (197 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight. CUP-UP poultry totaled 654 million pounds (296 thousand metric tons).

DEFINITIONS USED TO REPORT FEDERALLY INSPECTED SLAUGHTER

YOUNG CHICKENS - Commercially grown broilers-fryers and other young immature birds such as roasters and capons.

MATURE CHICKENS - Fowl from breeder and market egg flocks and stags and cocks.

FRYER-ROASTER TURKEYS - Young immature birds, usually under 16 weeks of age.

YOUNG TURKEYS (MATURE) - Young birds grown to a matured market age, about 5 months.

OLD TURKEYS (BREEDERS) - Fully matured birds held for egg production, usually over 15 months of age.

DUCKS - Includes all ducks regardless of age and weight.

OTHER POULTRY - Includes all other ready-to-cook products which bear the U.S.D.A. Inspected for Wholesomeness legend.
