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The preliminary total of LIVE WEIGHT POULTRY INSPECTIONS was 1.68 billion pounds (760 thousand metric tons) for February 1986.

Inspections included 1.39 billion pounds (631 thousand metric tons) of young chickens, 64.0 million pounds (29.0 thousand metric tons) of mature chickens, 210 million pounds (95.4 thousand metric tons) of turkeys and 10.6 million pounds (4830 metric tons) of ducks.

POULTRY CERTIFIED WHOLESOME during February 1986 was 1.22 billion pounds (554 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight. Updated totals for January 1986 show that 1.44 billion pounds (654 thousand metric tons) were certified.

ANTE-MORTEM CONDEMNATIONS during February 1986 totaled 6.39 million pounds (2900 metric tons). Condemnations were 0.38 percent of the live weight inspected, compared with 0.45 percent during February a year ago. POST-MORTEM CONDEMNATIONS, at 31.0 million pounds (14.1 thousand metric tons) (N.Y. Dressed Weight), were 2.06 percent of the quantities inspected compared with 2.00 percent a year earlier.

FURTHER PROCESSED poultry totaled 411 million pounds (187 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight. CUT-UP poultry totaled 659 million pounds (299 thousand metric tons).
