The preliminary total of LIVE WEIGHT POULTRY INSPECTIONS was 2.06 billion pounds (933 thousand metric tons) for April 1986.

Inspections included 1.71 billion pounds (774 thousand metric tons) of young chickens, 81.7 million pounds (37.1 thousand metric tons) of mature chickens, 256 million pounds (116 thousand metric tons) of turkeys and 12.7 million pounds (5770 metric tons) of ducks.

POULTRY CERTIFIED WHOLESOME during April 1986 was 1.50 billion pounds (682 thousand metric tons) ready to-cook weight. Updated totals for March 1986 show that 1.36 billion pounds (619 thousand metric tons) were certified.

ANTE-MORTEM CONDEMNATIONS during April 1986 totaled 5.93 million pounds (2690 metric tons). Condemnations were 0.28 percent of the live weight inspected, unchanged from April a year ago. POST-MORTEM CONDEMNATIONS, at 34.9 million pounds (15.8 thousand metric tons) (N.Y. Dressed Weight), were 1.89 percent of quantities inspected compared with 1.74 percent a year earlier.

FURTHER PROCESSED poultry totaled 423 million pounds (192 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight. CUT-UP poultry totaled 764 million pounds (347 thousand metric tons).

DEFINITIONS USED TO REPORT FEDERALLY INSPECTED SLAUGHTER:

YOUNG CHICKENS - Commercially grown broilers-fryers and other young immature birds such as roasters and capons.

MATURE CHICKENS - Fowl from breeder and market egg flocks and stags and cocks.

FRYER-ROASTER TURKEYS - Young immature birds, usually under 16 weeks of age.

YOUNG TURKEYS (MATURE) - Young birds grown to a matured market age, about 5 months.

OLD TURKEYS (BREEDERS) - Fully matured birds held for egg production, usually over 15 months of age.

DUCKS - Includes all ducks regardless of age and weight.

OTHER POULTRY - Includes all other ready-to-cook products which bear the U.S.D.A. Inspected for Wholesomeness legend.
