The preliminary total of LIVE WEIGHT POULTRY INSPECTIONS was 2.05 billion pounds (932 thousand metric tons) for June 1986.

Inspections included 1.63 billion pounds (737 thousand metric tons) of young chickens, 77.2 million pounds (35.0 thousand metric tons) of mature chickens, 339 million pounds (154 thousand metric tons) of turkeys and 13.3 million pounds (6050 metric tons) of ducks.

POULTRY CERTIFIED WHOLESOME during June 1986 was 1.51 billion pounds (686 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight. Updated totals for May 1986 show that 1.52 billion pounds (690 thousand metric tons) were certified.

ANTE-MORTEM CONDEMNATIONS during June 1986 totaled 7.81 million pounds (3540 metric tons). Condemnations were 0.38 percent of the live weight inspected, compared to 0.36 percent a year ago. POST-MORTEM CONDEMNATIONS, at 32.0 million pounds (14.5 thousand metric tons) (N.Y. Dressed Weight), were 1.73 percent of quantities inspected compared with 1.55 percent a year earlier.

FURTHER PROCESSED poultry totaled 480 million pounds (218 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight. CUT-UP poultry totaled 750 million pounds (340 thousand metric tons).

DEFINITIONS USED TO REPORT FEDERALLY INSPECTED SLAUGHTER:

YOUNG CHICKENS - Commercially grown broilers-fryers and other young immature birds such as roasters and capons.

MATURE CHICKENS - Fowl from breeder and market egg flocks and stags and cocks.

FRYER-ROASTER TURKEYS - Young immature birds, usually under 16 weeks of age.

YOUNG TURKEYS (MATURE) - Young birds grown to a matured market age, about 5 months.

OLD TURKEYS (BREEDERS) - Fully matured birds held for egg production, usually over 15 months of age.

DUCKS - Includes all ducks regardless of age and weight.

OTHER POULTRY - Includes all other ready-to-cook products which bear the U.S.D.A. Inspected for Wholesomeness legend.
