The preliminary total of LIVE WEIGHT POULTRY INSPECTIONS was 2.13 billion pounds (968 thousand metric tons) for April 1987.

Inspections included 1.73 billion pounds (785 thousand metric tons) of young chickens, 78.8 million pounds (35.8 thousand metric tons) of mature chickens, 312 million pounds (142 thousand metric tons) of turkeys, and 12.1 million pounds (5480 metric tons) of ducks.

POULTRY CERTIFIED WHOLESOME during April 1987 was 1.57 billion pounds (712 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight. Updated totals for March 1987 show that 1.59 billion pounds (723 thousand metric tons) were certified.

ANTE-MORTEM CONDEMNATIONS during April 1987 totaled 6.53 million pounds (2960 metric tons). Condemnations were 0.30 percent of the live weight inspected compared with 0.28 percent a year ago. POST-MORTEM CONDEMNATIONS, at 35.2 million pounds (16.0 thousand metric tons) (N.Y. Dressed Weight), were 1.88 percent of quantities inspected compared with 1.83 percent a year earlier.

FURTHER PROCESSED poultry totaled 542 million pounds (246 thousand metric tons) ready-to-cook weight. CUT-UP poultry totaled 807 million pounds (366 thousand metric tons).

DEFINITIONS USED TO REPORT FEDERALLY INSPECTED SLAUGHTER:

YOUNG CHICKENS - Commercially grown broilers-fryers and other young immature birds such as roasters and capons.

MATURE CHICKENS - Fowl from breeder and market egg flocks and stags and cocks.

FRYER-ROASTER TURKEYS - Young immature birds, usually under 16 weeks of age.

YOUNG TURKEYS (MATURE) - Young birds grown to a matured market age, about 5 months.

OLD TURKEYS (BREEDERS) - Fully matured birds held for egg production, usually over 15 months of age.

DUCKS - Includes all ducks regardless of age and weight.

OTHER POULTRY - Includes all other ready-to-cook products which bear the U.S.D.A. Inspected for Wholesomeness legend.
