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The preliminary total of LIVE WEIGHT POULTRY INSPECTION was 2.38 billion pounds for May 1988.

Inspections included 1.87 billion pounds of young chickens, 81.5 million pounds of mature chickens, 414 million pounds of turkeys and 13.4 million pounds of ducks.

POULTRY CERTIFIED WHOLESOME during May 1988 was 1.75 billion pounds ready-to-cook weight. Updated totals for April 1988 show that 1.65 billion pounds were certified.

ANTE-MORTEM CONDEMNATIONS during May 1988 totaled 7.84 million pounds. Condemnations were 0.32 percent of the live weight inspected, unchanged from a year ago. POST-MORTEM CONDEMNATIONS, at 39.2 million pounds (N.Y. Dressed Weight), were 1.83 percent of quantities inspected compared with 1.77 percent a year earlier.

FURTHER PROCESSED poultry totaled 620 million pounds ready-to-cook weight. CUT-UP poultry totaled 886 million pounds.

MATURE CHICKENS - Fowl from breeder and market egg flocks and stags and cocks.

FRYER-ROASTER TURKEYS - Young immature birds, usually under 16 weeks of age.

YOUNG TURKEYS (MATURE) - Young birds grown to a matured market age, about 5 months.

OLD TURKEYS (BREEDERS) - Fully matured birds held for egg production, usually over 15 months of age.

DUCKS - Includes all ducks regardless of age and weight.

OTHER POULTRY - Includes all other ready-to-cook products which bear the U.S.D.A. Inspected for Wholesomeness legend.
