## SUGAR MARKET HIGHLIGHTS

### DELIVERIES

Sugar distribution for Continental consumption for the first half of 1987 totaled 3.9 million short tons, raw value, up 5 percent from last year. Sugar exports for January-June were 470,952 tons.

### INVENTORIES

Sugar stocks held by U.S. primary distributors on June 30, 1987, totaled 2.4 million short tons, raw value, 1 percent below a year ago.

### DOMESTIC PRODUCTION

Sugar production for the Mainland United States for January-June 1987 totaled 2.4 million short tons, raw value, up 25 percent from last year.

Hawaiian sugar production for January-June 1987 totaled 395,679 tons, down 10 percent from last year.

### IMPORTS

Receipts of raw imported sugar by U.S. cane refiners for January-June 1987 totaled 832,588 tons, down 22 percent from a year ago. The Dominican Republic with 227,068 tons and Mexico with 101,072 tons accounted for the largest and second largest suppliers of tonnage.
